Nation Builder Award Presentation Dr. Sayeegeetha Hegde, HOD of Humanities at Nitte Deemed to be University, received the Nation Builder Award for her outstanding contributions to Tulu language and literature.

Guest Dr. Hegde spoke on the evolution and significance of the Tulu language, referencing the work of scholars like Dr. M. Govinda Pai, Dr. S.U. Panniyadi, Dr. D.N. Shankar Bhat, and Dr. Padmanabha Kekunnaya.

#### **Key Insights on Tulu Language:**

- Tulu is a South Dravidian language with historical ties to Malayalam, Tamil, and Kannada.
- It diverged early from Proto-South Dravidian, developing unique grammatical features.
- The language shares many cognates and loanwords from Sanskrit.
- The Tigalari script, once used to write Sanskrit and later Tulu and Kannada, reflects its literary heritage.
- Tulu sentence structures show similarities with other South Indian languages. Examples: "Yaan erenkenodu?" (Tulu) vs. "Naanu Yaarannakenbeku?" (Kannada).

#### **Historical and Cultural Context:**

- Tulu Nadu spans coastal Karnataka and northern Kerala.
- Rich in oral traditions-Paddanas, Sandis, and folk songs.
- The Tulu script, derived from Grantha, was used primarily by priestly communities.
- German missionaries introduced printing in Kannada script, aiding preservation but contributing to the decline of the original script.
