It was initially used by the first Rotary Club in Chicago and symbolized civilization and movement. In 1912, it was validated by the Association of Rotary Clubs and "Rotary International" was added to the wheel. A new wheel was adopted in 1929, which is still used today.

- The wheel includes: 6 spokes
- 24 teeth symbolizing the spirit of service at any hour of the day
- A keying groove to lock the wheel on its axis and make it functional.
