ONAM CELEBRATIONS

Onam is celebrated in Kerala in remembrance of the good governance under the rule of Mahabali, a mythical king who ruled Kerala. The legend holds that jealous of Mahabali's popularity and his power, the devas and gods conspired to end his reign. Lord Vishnu came to earth as Vamana in the form of a dwarf Brahmin who trampled Mahabali to Patala (netherworld). However, witnessing Mahabali's generosity, Vishnu granted the king's sole wish to visit his land & people once every year. This homecoming of Mahabali is celebrated as Onam in Kerala every year. This is also the harvest festival of Kerala.



Onam falls in the month of Chingam, which is the first month according to the Malayalam Calendar. This is generally end of August to beginning of September as per the Gregorian Calendar. The celebrations mark the Malayalam New Year, and is spread over ten days, and conclude with Thiruvonam. Other days have a diverse range of celebrations and activities ranging from boat races, cultural programs, sports competitions, dance events, martial arts, floral Rangoli-pookkalam, prayers, shopping, donating time or food for charity to spending time with family over feasts. Men and women wear traditional dress. The Kerala sari or Kasavu sari is particularly wore on this day.

The celebrations reach their peak on the auspicious day of Thiruvonam. Households are adorned with exquisite floral carpets (Pookkalam), traditional art forms and games are seen everywhere and homes are cleaned and decorated. Onam is also famous for the special vegetarian meal known as 'Ona Sadhya' which is served on a plantain leaf. This include delicacies such as kuthari choru, sambar, rasam, pappadam, kondattam, manga pickle, pineapple pachadi, kai uperi (banana chips), pal payasam, jaggery payasam and much more.

Brief report of the meeting held on 17th September 2024. Past President Rtn.

Ganesh Krishna Bhat presided in the absence of President Rtn. Mohan Nair and welcomed all. Rtn. Raghavan rendered invocation. **Rtn. Shambhavi Prabhu** informed in her classification talk that she was born and brought up in Mangalore. Had her early education in Lady Hill School and got degree from Canara College. After graduation she applied for Bank jobs and got selected for Syndicate Bank. She further informed that our Senior member Rtn. T. G. Shenoy was the Head of the interview panel which selected her. She got her first posting at Belgaum in 1987. She liked her work and also liked the place for its weather and scenic beauty. Later she got transferred to Mangalore and worked in many places including Bangalore, Mumbai etc. She loved her job as it involved helping people by giving them loans for business, house construction, vehicles and education. Syte Bank got merged with Canara Bank which did not cause much difficulty for her work as both were south based banks. Her toughest assignment was during Covid time when she was working in Mumbai. Running the bank was very difficult due to shortage of staff and also very difficult conditions as she had to go on deputation to various branches spread over the large area of Mumbai. She got married with Rtn. M. S. Prabhu who was working in Canara Bank and they are blessed with a daughter who is married and well settled in Bangalore. She joined Rotary Club while she was Senior Manager of Canara Bank Car Street Branch due to the efforts of Rtn. T. G. Shenoy and she is very happy with the club.

Next **Rtn. Pundalika Nayak** informed that he was born in a traditional undivided agriculturist family having 180 acres of agricultural land. After land reforms came the lands of the family was lost and his father has to start doing other businesses. He said that he was also doing part time work like affixing beedi labels etc. while simultaneously finished degree in Mechanical engineering from Nitte Engineering College. After that he got job at Special Economic Zone Mangalore through the help of family friend. He is now involved in water treatment for supply to all the units of SEZ. He also looks after fire and safety of SEZ. He informed that SEZ is spread over 1800 acres of land and several times leopards come there and he has devised a leopard trap to capture them. He further said that he still lives in his ancestral large house in the village. His father had written a story which was made into a Konkani Movie " Tarpan " which was completely shot in his house. He said that he had the good fortune to act in the movie in a small role.

Dr. Prabha Adhikari informed that a zoom meeting for all the Rotary Clubs of the District could be done to educate about Old age Awareness. Further she said that on account of Alzheimer's Day PAGE has organised a competition for Senior and Super Seniors at Rotary Bhavan on 25.09.2024 at 3 pm and requested everybody to come and participate.

Rtn Dr. Shivaprasad informed that under the DDF grant of \$ 728 to our club it is proposed to donate a Threadmill to Chethana Child Development Centre and Adamya Chethana Day Care Centre for Divyangas at Madhava Vana, Montepadavu, Naringana. The club members approved the same. Rtn. Raghavan informed about the installation ceremony of the Interact Club of St. Lawrence School Bondel on 11.09.2024 and said that a total of 112 interactors joined the club.

PP Rtn. Dr. Prakash K. E. informed that our Rotary Club in association with KMC Attavar and NSS is organising a Medical Camp at Shree Devi Institute of Technology, Kenjar on 20th September and requested all members to attend. In the end Rtn. Dr. Sukesh Rao proposed the vote of thanks.
