A dedicated spiritual leader and a beloved disciple of Sadguru Sri Mata Amritanandamayi Devi (AMMA).

Swamini Amma continues to spread AMMA's message of love and selfless service, inspiring countless individuals on their spiritual and humanitarian journey. The Month of February in Rotary is World Understanding and Peace and Conflict Prevention/resolution month.

The month of February is very special in the Rotary calendar because it includes the anniversary of the first meeting of Rotary held on February 23, 1905, now designated as the "World Understanding and Peace Day".

Millions of people all over the world are currently displaced by armed conflict or persecution. In fact, 90% of casualties in armed conflicts are civilians, half of

Rotarians train adults and young leaders to prevent and mediate conflict, and aid refugees who have fled dangerous areas. In designating World Understanding Month, the Rotary International Board asks all Rotary clubs to plan programs for their weekly meetings and undertake special activities to emphasize "understanding and goodwill as essential for world peace".

World Understanding Month is a chance for every club to pause, plan and promote the Fourth Avenue of Service-Rotary's continued quest for goodwill, peace and understanding among people of the world.

RI President Stephanie Urchick and other Rotary members are organizing a Presidential peace conference on February 20-22, 2025 in Istanbul, Turkiye. The theme of the conference is " Healing in a Divided World". "Rotary is an organization founded on the principle of advancing world understanding, goodwill, and peace. It is our responsibility to promote peace," says Urchick, who has made this topic a focus of her presidency. "I am expecting the conference will help showcase Rotary's role in a variety of peacebuilding stakeholders, including our partners, trustees, and directors; some of the 1,800 peace center alumni; members of our Rotary Action Group for Peace; and others with an interest in advancing peace," Urchick says.

Conference sessions will promote approaches to conflict resolution that are based on empathy and critical thinking. With these skills, current and future generations can find ways to resolve disputes without violence.

Through global grant activities, clubs and districts can participate in strategically focused, high-impact activities that align with Rotary goals that address this area of focus including to train leaders including potential youth leaders to prevent and mediate conflict, support peacebuilding in communities and regions affected by conflict, and support studies related to peace and conflict prevention/resolution for career-minded professionals.
