Agenda: District Governor's Visit

Welcome Address: The President, Rtn. Dr. M. S. Arun Kumar Shetty, extended a warm welcome to the District Governor (DG) Rtn. Ramakrishna P. K., Assistant Governor (AG) Rtn. Address by the Assistant Governor: AG Rtn. CA Shantharam Shetty appreciated the club's sustained efforts in conducting meaningful, service-oriented programs that create a positive impact in society.

Address by the District Governor: Following his introduction and felicitation, the DG addressed the gathering and warmly commended the club for its exemplary progress and purposeful vision. He lauded the club for accomplishing the TRF-Annual Fund (TRF-AF) raising goal, for strengthening membership by admitting nine lady members, and for planning with foresight and discipline.
