Dr. Palakshappa brings with him more than 30 years of experience in teaching, research, and academic administration. Academically, Dr. Palakshappa holds a Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering, a Master's degree in Hydraulics & Irrigation Engineering, an MIT in Information Science, and a Ph.D. in Civil Engineering from NITK, Surathkal. His doctoral research on the Impact Assessment of Watershed Development Programs is a testament to his commitment to sustainable infrastructure and environmental engineering.

Dr. Palakshappa has played an influential role in university-level governance and professional bodies: He has served as a Member of the Board of Examiners for both VTU Belgaum and Kuvempu University.

He is a recognized Ph.D. examiner and research guide, currently mentoring five Ph.D. scholars under VTU. He was appointed as a Governing Council Member of G. Marigouda Institute of Technology by VTU.

He has contributed to the Kannada Literature and Books Publication Committee of VTU. He is also part of the Academic Council at Dayananda Sagar College of Engineering, Bangalore.

Dr. Palakshappa is a reviewer for international journals, a life member of several professional bodies such as the Indian Society for Technical Education, the Association of Consulting Civil Engineers, and the GRSS-IEEE India.
