

will help us stay focused.


- Be Open to Change: New ideas and approaches are important. The world is always changing, and we need to adapt.

Ajay Kumar Jain combines academic success with a fervent passion for sports and adventure, shaping him into a versatile and accomplished professional.






Dr. Prasanna Kakunje

Secretary's Report Highlights

Club Service:

Throughout the year, our club organized 52 weekly meetings, including classification talks and family dinners. We held 12 Board of Directors meetings to discuss club matters. We enjoyed fellowship through picnics, an international trip, cultural events like 'Kesarad Gobbu', and a club badminton tournament. We co-hosted a District Sports event and organized 1 Rotaract and 5 Interact installations. Additionally, we strengthened relationships with other clubs through 4 joint meetings and hosted a Zonal Review Meet.

Community Service:

Under Community Service, our club completed 25 projects, including financial aid for students, supplying school and anganwadi equipment, supporting children with special needs, and providing medical aid. We donated a laptop to Moodbidri Police Station, planted trees during Vanamahotsava, and ran campaigns for a plastic-free environment. We gave blankets to hospital staff, organized health check-ups and student counseling, and supported cultural events like the Muddu Krishna Competition. Notably, we held a free dog sterilization and vaccination camp and installed a Sanitary Napkin Disposal Machine at Rotary English Medium School. Collaborating with Gram Panchayat Hosangady and Selco Solar Pvt Ltd, we

installed solar lights. We sponsored college fees for a needy student and took part in voter-awareness campaigns.



Vocational Service:

In our commitment to Vocational Service, we recognized and honored achievers and contributors across various fields. This included honoring a retired government school principal, a Kannada writer, senior teachers of Rotary institutions, and a Kambala Otagara performer.

TRF Contribution:

Our club members made significant contributions totaling more than USD 9000 towards The Rotary Foundation (TRF).

Utilization of District Grant:

We efficiently utilized the District Grant fund amounting to Rs. 1,59,000. This enabled us to provide computers with peripherals and a printer to several schools and the BEO Office in Moodbidri. Additionally, we supplied and installed playground equipment for the Bannadka Anganwadi.

This comprehensive report highlights our club's dedication to service and community engagement throughout the year.


