

From Secretary's Desk Annual Report 2024–25

Under Club Service

- · We began the year with the Installation Ceremony of our new president and office bearers at Paradise Hall, Nishmitha Towers, marking the start of an inspiring new Rotary year.
- · A major highlight was hosting the 'VISTARA' District Seminar for Zone 1 to 5 clubs at Kandiga Greens, Belvai, with over 600 Rotarians in attendance—the highest ever for such an event in our district.
- On June 18th, 2025, Rotary Club Moodubidire, in collaboration with CDDIndia and other partners, successfully released a book highlighting the importance of rejuvenation and preservation of lakes in and around Moodubidire, including the lakes and tanks of Jaina Kashi Moodubidire. The event also focused on promoting conservation and engaging the community in preserving these vital water resources.
- · In the Zonal Cultural Competition, our members won accolades in skit and stand-up performances, showcasing their creativity and talent.
- · A proud moment came when Rtn. A.K. Rao was honored for being appointed President of the Karnataka State Cashew Growers Association.
- Among the most enjoyable events was our Rotary Picnic at Glucklich Cottage, Kundapur, where 42 Rotarians bonded over food and fellowship. Another fun-filled picnic at Divine Park, Muniyalu, saw 80 members participate, during which Mr. Ramakrishna Achar of SKF Industries was felicitated under Vocational Service for his contributions to agriculture and industry.
- · We proudly hosted the Zonal Review Meeting for Zone 4 at Paradise Hall, showcasing our commitment to collaboration and planning.

Under Community Service

- · Our visit to an old age home in Maroor Village brought joy to 20 elderly residents, to whom we donated a food grinder and gas stove.
- · In observance of Vanamahotsava, we planted saplings at various locations including Rotary Schools and the Kadalakere Forest Area, in collaboration with the Forest Department and Inner Wheel Club.
- · We supported education by donating uniforms to 25 Anganwadi children at Daragudde and organized Roto Connect programs in Yedapadavu, Siddakatte, Bannadaka, and Shirthady, covering topics such as health, postal services, and cybercrime awareness.
- · In our commitment to health, we conducted a Blood Donation Camp in collaboration with Rotary Alvas Blood Bank, collecting 54 units. We also organized a drug de-addiction awareness program at SNM Polytechnic, educating over 100 students.

- · We also distributed nutritious food to children under Maternal and Child Health, at Moodbidri Government Hospital.
- · We held a First Aid Health Camp at Vitala Somanatheshwara Temple, benefiting 75 people. Under WASH in Schools, we installed water purifiers at schools: Vivekananda High School, Yedapadavu, Prerana Higher Primary School, Kadalakere, Babu Rajendra High School, Moodbidri and Rotary School, Moodbidri.
- · We conducted a cotton carry bag distribution drive at Moodbidri Swaraj Maidan, encouraging people to say "No to Plastic".

Under Vocational Service

- · We honored Mr. Ramachandra Naik, an ex-serviceman and retired Subedar Major, and top-performing SSLC students from various government schools with cash prizes and books.
- · We recognized & honoured Rtn. Dr. Ramesh & Rtn. Dr. Muralikrishna who have become the major Donor & other members who received Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) awards for their contributions to The Rotary Foundation.
- · During our Teachers' Day celebration at Rotary Sammilana Hall, we felicitated long-serving teachers such as Mrs. Tilaka Anathaveera Jain, Mrs. Sujatha R. Shetty, Sarita J., and Supriya, in collaboration with Vijayalakshmi Foundation, which sponsored their cash prizes.
- · Guest speakers like Sri Lakshminarayan P.S. and Mr. Harish B. enriched our vocational knowledge. Rtn. Ragupathi S. Bhat, Chartered Accountant, delivered an informative session on Income Tax and GST.

Under Youth Service

- We installed new office bearers for Interact Clubs at multiple institutions, including Rotary English Medium School, Rotary PU College, Rotary CBSE School, and Jawaharlal Nehru High School, Shirthady & Government High School Neerkere.
