

The Rising Burden of Heart Attacks in India: A Holistic Approach to Prevention

A Silent Epidemic: Young Hearts Under Siege

India is witnessing an unprecedented crisis in cardiovascular health, with heart attacks now striking alarmingly young populations. Recent data paints a grim picture:

- A 40% surge in heart attacks among those under 40 post-pandemic (Times of India, 2023)
- Fit individuals, including marathon runners, collapsing from cardiac events weeks after COVID recovery (The Hindu, 2022)
- · Hospitals reporting tripled cases of blocked arteries in 25-35 year olds (Hindustan Times, 2024) Cardiovascular diseases (CVDs) now account for 28% of deaths in India (GBD 2023).

The culprits? Sedentary lifestyles, processed foods, air pollution, and post-COVID vascular damage (??) Modern Medicine's Take:

Key Risk Factors enlists-

- 1. Metabolic Disorders: Diabetes (101 million cases), hypertension (1 in 3 adults).
- 2. Lifestyle: Smoking (27% prevalence), vaping, lack of exercise.
- 3. Post-COVID Effects: Micro clots, chronic inflammation.

COVID-19 Vaccines: Separating Facts from Myths

mRNA vaccines: Rare myocarditis (2-10/100,000 doses in young males)

Adenovirus vectors: Minimal thrombosis risk (1/50,000-250,000)

Consensus: Infection risk >> vaccine risk (WHO/ICMR)
