Nigeria: Rotary Foundation helps reduce high maternal death

In Abuja, Nigeria's political capital, a woman is rushed to the hospital. A nurse runs toward her saying "She has lost a lot of blood, We don't want her to die here."

Their ministrations are futile. The woman slumps in the wheelchair. The nurse looks up and delivers a belated admonishment. "The safest way is to deliver in the hospital," she says. "You see what has happened to this woman? We have lost her. We have lost her!"

In 2020, 82,000 pregnant women and new mothers died in Nigeria, nearly four times the maternal fatalities in India, where the second-most deaths occur. Why? Sixty percent of births in Nigeria take place in traditional methods, at home. The main causes for death:

1. Post delivery haemorrhage
2. Obstructed labor
3. Eclampsia or seizures during pregnancy
4. High blood pressure
5. Organ damage.

Now Rotary Foundation is addressing this with a \$2 million Program. The Rotary-supported program

addresses these problems through education, workshops and partnership with other health agencies.
