8th of July 2020, at the clock tick of 12.15pm, MC of the Day Rtn. Rakesh Babu began the installation ceremony at Hotel Pai Vista convention hall, neatly decorated, with every one entering thru three colourful doors, being theme logo. As one entered, a true spirit of friendship and joy of meeting fellow Rotarians was very much visible with everyone greeting each other with a big smile.

Meeting began in the right earnest with the Shanthi mantra and a minute of silence as a mark of respect to Corona warriors and the soldiers martyred in the Galwan Valley.

Introduction of chief guest was done by the showman of midtown Rtn. Harish in a very unique way, goes to show the immense talent this veteran Midtowner has exhibited over last 30 years of his being in club. Installing officer PDG Rtn. Dr. Nagarjuna's intro was done by Rtn. Dr. Prahlad.

Every board member holding placards with Rotary's contribution during Covid times and precautionary messages of Covid-19 were introduced by the one and only MC Rtn. Rakesh. His introduction of each member by 3 unique attributes went well with the 3 doors of RI theme and team logo Jataayu. Turning around the placards by all the members was a message "Thank You for Coming" was very unique and one of the highlights. PDG Rtn. Nagarjuna pinned the board members and installed the new board

Installing officer and our own good friend PDG Rtn. Dr. Nagarjuna, started with acknowledgments to the seniors of our club, viz, Rtn. Ramki, Alagappan, Bhanu, Raghu. Addressing the gathering he said, as early as March 2nd week, sensing danger of Covid-19, RI advised all the clubs to



embrace "Work from Home" culture and acted swiftly to contribute 3 million USD, adding to kitty was the collection of RI convention, which was also transferred for the cause. Among the many districts that received the Covid-19 grants was Chamarajanagar, Mysore, Coorg and Mangalore by way of equipments and medical supplies to Covid-19 hospitals. President Aiyanna in his acceptance speech thanked all the members for their support , a special mention was made of Rtn. Raghu Uncle who introduced him to Midtown and his parents and gave a road map of his activities for the year. Speaking on the occasion Asst. Governor Rtn. Chief guest Addanda Cariappa, director of Rangayana, started his address by applauding Rtn. Harish's introduction of himself, praising Aiyanna for taking the lead to run the club during this crisis period. My Unforgettable Moments in Rotary...

My Four Decades with Midtown

"We may run, walk, stumble, drive, or fly, but let us never lose sight of the reason for the journey or miss a chance to see a rainbow on the way."

My memorable journey in Rotary began in 1980 when a few senior Rotarians of our parent club decided to bring together a group of thirty six people from different walks of life to form a new Rotary club and The Rotary Club of Mysore Midtown came into being. The following year, the Charter was presented. Mysore being a small city, most of us already knew each other. Our charter member Vivek of Kings Kourt offered his premises to conduct our weekly meetings. The initial years were invested to build bonhomie and camaraderie with a lot of fun and frolic activities. This effort paid off and the result is visible even today.

During one of the club picnics when Madhwa Rao was the club President, the discussion turned towards involving Rotarians in service activities. The concept of 'Project a week' was born. I vividly recall a very gratifying project that my partner D.Srinath and I took up. Srinath came across a young boy who was dumb because he was deaf. We got him tested at AIISH and we were told that the youngster would be able to speak if helped with a hearing aid which in those days costed Rs 2000/, however with an income certificate from the Tahsildar, it could be available free of cost. We met the Tahsildar and introduced ourselves as Rotarians wanting to help a poor boy.

Within minutes the certificate was issued and to cut a long story short, the boy was able to speak very soon. This was my introduction to the power and reach of Rotary!

One incident that is etched in my memory happened in 1984 when Dr Kanakaraj was the club President. It was the Dist Governor's official visit to our club and the day my mother expired. I was overwhelmed when DG Rtn Shantaram with my Rotarian friends visited my house. This was indeed very touching and in the true spirit of Rotary. I was introduced to the caring friendship in Rotary.

Over the years, our club has taken up innumerable activities in areas hitherto unexplored whether it was to build fellowship, serve the community or to raise funds. Some fond memories are, The Star Night, The National RYLA, Aap Ki Adalat, Diksoochi,

Bandhavya, Fellowship Cricket, Tennis tournaments, Firecrackers saleThe best part was getting together and working together, the chatter and banter, healthy arguments, eating together and always ending with hearty laughter. Every year, the installation ceremony is a novelty and one occasion that I look forward to.

A dream come true for Rotary Midtown is the Rotary Midtown Academy (RMA) which is now a full fledged school from Kindergarten to High School. The Herculean task right from acquiring the site, constructing the building, and getting the school running has been achieved thanks to the efforts and the determination of our Rotarians.

Rotary Midtown has instituted six prestigious awards for achievers in various fields: The Amaravani Award for Teachers, The Silicon Award for Journalists, The Best Industrialist Award, The Shramajeevi Award for workers, The Namana Award for Performing Arts, The Sainik Deshratna Award for the Armed Forces.

The formation of the Rotary Academy for Creative Excellence (RACE) is one initiative which is very close to my heart. Along with three of my Rotarian friends, I have travelled to the nook and corner of erstwhile Rotary Dist 3180 reaching out to thousands of rural children to help them build self confidence and to pursue their passion. We have met and addressed teachers and parents to help them improve their skills in molding children.

Today, after forty glorious years, I am the only charter member in the club. With immense gratitude and reverence I acknowledge the role of Rotary in grooming me. I have learned from stalwarts who became my role models and also from youngsters who energize me and help me to stay young at heart.

From middle of 1st lockdown Rtn. Nagaraj along with other volunteers used to pack up the ration to be distributed to the needy. This was the project of Rotary Mysore, GSS and the District Administration. Daily they used to pack 10 kg of rice, 2 kg dal, 2 kg wheat flour, 2 kg of raagi powder and 1 litre oil. They used to pack around 400 in a day, from Morning 11 to 4.30 in the evening. Naagi went to Vidyaranya complex and Jayamma Govindgowda choultry and did it for almost one and a half months. In between he used to go to ISKON for ready food packing, through Akshaya patra. They used to pack 300gm rice, 300 gm sambar/ rasam, 2 chapatis, 250 gm kootu. Well-done Nagi. We are proud of you.
