

CLUB PROJECTS FOR 2025-26 - HIGHLIGHTS

Known for its purposeful and innovative community work, the Rotary Club of Mysore West continues its commitment to service in 2025–26 with impactful initiatives across education, health, and vocational training.

The Club's two higher secondary schools at Saraswathipuram and Dattagalli are set for growth with plans to enhance admissions, upgrade infrastructure, and strengthen teaching quality through retraining and recruitment of well-qualified educators. An auditorium for the children to have their own place for their programmes is being constructed at the School in Dattagalli. It will be completed shortly The Paul Harris Vocational Training Institute, already offering courses in tailoring, fashion design, computer basics, and solar system maintenance, will expand into new trades like mobile phone and AC/refrigerator servicing—enabling broader skill-building and livelihood opportunities.

Healthcare remains a strong focus under the leadership of Community Services Director Dr. Basavaraju R. The club will continue regular free health check-up camps, targeted vaccination drives (including for HPV, Hepatitis, and Typhoid), and blood donation efforts. Mobile outreach units will serve rural areas, while wellness programs will address physical and mental health through school workshops, BLS training, yoga, counselling, and rehabilitation camps. Health cards for the underprivileged, senior care initiatives, and sanitation drives will further support community well-being.

The club's mission-mode Cervical Cancer Vaccination Project led by Dr. Sonia Mandappa will continue with vigour, aiming for wider coverage through school and community engagement. As a part of our Golden jubilee, the present building is being upgraded. Immediate plan is to improve, Auxiliary power generator system, audio video system, which includes an LED Video wall system replacing the present projection screen. Long term plan of converting it to an AC hall may also be taken up this year. Our signature projects Save A Child and Save A Life will be strengthened by involving more hospitals and providing greater financial aid. The ongoing dental care program for Central Jail inmates will also be reinforced.

The club is also considering proposing a global grant project for establishing a skin bank in the city. Together, these projects reflect the club's enduring spirit of service, inclusiveness, and innovation.
