Mumbai Rotaractors have spotlighted women trafficking through initiatives like the "Cheekh" project and the

creation of Anti-Human Trafficking (AHT) clubs. The Rotaract District 3141 has also emphasized awareness through collaborations and various events.

Rotaract clubs in Mumbai have organized major campaigns such as "Cheekh" to bring attention to women trafficking. The Rotaract Club of Jai Hind College led this project, which involved several awareness activities:

In 2015 and 2016, they performed street plays at various public places across Mumbai, including Infiniti Mall, airports, and Sterling Cinemas.

The project also included a movie release about trafficking on International Women's Day.

In January 2025, Rotaract District 3141 expanded its anti-trafficking efforts by inaugurating several Anti-Human Trafficking (AHT) clubs in colleges across Mumbai. The initiative empowers students with knowledge and practical ways to combat human trafficking both online and offline. The participating colleges include R.A. Podar College, Ramnarain Ruia Autonomous College, and SM Shetty College.

05.10.2025: The Social Forestry Project **(District Project Hasire Usiru)** is joint project of RC Manipal in association with SKDRP, Grama Panchayat, Havanje, Havanje Grama Vikas Committee & The Forest Dept Udupi. 500 fruit yielding saplings were planted in the forest area of Havanje. Project cost is Rs. 85,000, out of which around RS. 40,000 was pooled in by Rotarians of RC Manipal. The project was executed under the leadership of Project Chairman Rtn. 
