Overview

The Joint Meeting hosted by RC Manipal, RC Manipal Town, and IFMR Udupi Subchapter marked a significant moment in welcoming the Rotary K2K IFMR India Rally Riders, who are on a nationwide mission promoting peace, environmental sustainability, and preventive health. With inspiring addresses by the Ride Captain, AG, and DG, active participation from both clubs, ceremonial flag exchanges, and symbolic sapling plantation, the event showcased Rotary's unity and commitment to service. The gathering culminated with DG Palaksha flagging off the riders to their next destination, Goa, amidst warm wishes for a safe and impactful journey.

RC Manipal, RC Manipal Town, and IFMR Udupi Subchapter jointly organized a memorable meeting with the IFMR India K2K Riders as part of the Rotary K2K IFMR India Rally—a Pan-India initiative from Kanyakumari to Kashmir promoting Peace through Environment and Health. The rally features around 30 Rotarians riding over 14,000 km in 17 days, covering 43 Rotary Districts via three routes— Central, Western, and Eastern-between November 4 and 30, 2025. On November 6th, a warm breakfast meeting was held to welcome the 10 Riders of the Western Route, supported by Ride Captain Rtn. Ajit S Ram. The gathering began at 8:00 am with a grand welcome, followed by a sumptuous breakfast.

The stage program commenced with an invocation by Rtn. Geetha Kausik, after which RCM President Rtn. Shashikala Rajavarma extended a heartfelt welcome to the IFMR team and members of both clubs. In his presentation, Ride Captain Rtn. Ajit S Ram highlighted the rally's vision: three teams with one mission—to unite communities through shared purpose and dialogue, emphasizing Environmental Sustainability, Preventive Health and Wellbeing, Peace through Collective Action, and Rotary's flagship mission to End Polio.


