Rotary International, particularly in India, actively promotes organ donation through awareness campaigns, educational sessions, and initiatives like the Rotary Club of Organ Donation, the world's first specialized, cause-based club for this cause. Members run advocacy programs, including walkathons and school, education, to encourage donor registration, notably supporting the NOTTO portal to increase the low, 0.01% donor rate in India. Key initiatives and activities include:

Specialized Advocacy: The Rotary Club of Organ Donation International (RCODI) works globally, collaborating with groups like the Rotary e-Club of Organ Donation UK.

Awareness Campaigns: Regular talks, seminars, and web-based initiatives, such as the [Rotary Club of Delhi Manthan's pledge form](#), are used to educate the public and clear misconceptions about organ donation.

Medical Collaboration: Rotary members support the coordination of transplant training for medical staff and expand access to kidney and liver surgeries.

Governmental Links: Projects often led to formal pledging via government bodies like the National Organ & Tissue Transplant Organisation (NOTTO).

Rotary India Action: Dedicated to educating about the critical need for organs.
