Cabin Schools of Pune is a very noble literacy mission by the Rotary Club of Pimpri, RID 3131, Published in the Rotary News of July 2025. Imagine a situation, where you have schools to study and achieve your dreams! For many children in the slums of Sangvi, Pune, the idea of sitting in a classroom and learning, was a distant dream. But now, it is a reality, with the Porta Cabin School set up inside a repurposed shipping container. The school stands on an open ground in New Sangvi, Pimpri - Chinchward. Children aged 6-16 are admitted. Teachers from The Jan Sewa Foundation conduct classes. Marathi, Hindi and Maths are taught. Currently 50 children attend. No fixed syllabus or grades & school dropouts. Even adults can walk in and learn. Apart from academics, they attend workshops to make them self-reliant. Medical camps are held to ensure good health. The president of the club, Santosh Giranje says, "When children do not have a purpose in life, they get easily attracted to habit forming vices."
