


Rotary Information by Rtn Nagaraj Shetty

Major resolution debated and approved in the meeting

- 1. Increase in the RI dues per member by U\$D 3.50 for 2026-27 and another 3.75 USD in each of the following 2 years. Per capita dues will increase from 82 for 2025-26 to USD 85.50 for 2026-27.
- 2. COL approved a measure to allow clubs to be chartered with 15 members instead of 20.
- 3. Voted after extensive debate to make holding an annual district conference optional.
- 4. Agreed to allow the board to consider culture and language in addition the number of Rotarian's in deciding the boundaries of Zone

A few resolutions debated but not approved.

- 1. Age restricts for Rotaractors
- 2. Restrict 5% of the members as honorary members
