

Rtn. Dr. Shantharam was born in 1928. He did his Master's Degree with First Rank from Central College, Bangalore in 1951. He completed Ph.D. from London University in 1954. He has worked in versatile field like education, administration, art, drama & literature. He was a stage actor and participated in drama including "Hamlet" and was a member of Rangabhumni Kshetra. He was a Fellow of the Entomological Society of India. He served as faculty in various educational institutions. He also served as HOD of Basic Science, KMC, Manipal. He served as Principal of Bhandarskar College, Kundapura. He joined Rotary in 1962. He became the RCM President in the year 1972-73, He became the District Governor for RI Dist. 3180 in the year 1984-85. He is a major Donor of TRF. His educational expertise, mastery in rules & regulations, discipline, administration, thoroughness, intelligence, planned execution, trouble shooting, organising skill – has made him a guide & mentor to all other Rotarians.

Ann Vijayalaxmi is the strong support behind Dr. Shantharam. She travelled with her husband and seeing new places, meeting new people was learning experience for her.
