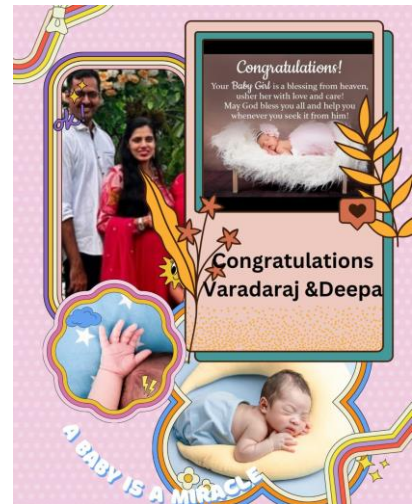


30.10.2024 & 31.10.2024: Rotaract Club Mahe distributed clothes to housekeeping staffs of health science campus hostels.
