In his tenure, he did a course in Bomb Disposal. After Bombay Terrorist Attack, he applied for VRS. He did farming in Belavai for some time.



He worked as Training Executive in Manipal University. Later he worked in RCC Cruice Liner for 2 years & travelled South Asia & European Countries. He worked in UK Embassy for 2 years. He along with his wife is running a catering business, He opened a food factory, New Stall Open Products in Hiriyadka. He also has opened Jambu Security Agency and has around 600 employees recruited. He has joined various service organisations like JCl & Rotary. His two children are going to School. Thus, he has gained versatile experience in various field.

After the Classification Talk, Rtn. Shrikanth Prabhu conducted an interesting session on Artificial Intelligence. He explained that Artificial Intelligence is opposite of Human Intelligence. He also explained the technicalities behind the AI, that is, Data, Information, Risk Mitigation, Pattern Recognition, Pattern Classification, Grouping, Internet, Operating System & so on. He also explained the role of AI in Health Care, Sports, Business Forecast, Geopolitics, Infrastructure designing, Railway, Airways, Traffic Signalling System, Defence, Education, Law, Forensic etc. He said that AI does not remove job. It promotes job opportunities. It is important that all of them are aware of Cyber Security & Cyber Crime. Rtn. Shrikant concluded the session with a note, "I & We should see something which Nobody has".

According to legend, the sage Narada once visited Lord Shiva at his abode on Mount Kailash and presented him with the jnana palam (fruit of knowledge).
