In 2024, Rotary International and its Indian chapters undertook several significant projects addressing various community needs. Here are some of the main initiatives:

- Continued Polio Eradication Efforts: Rotary has vaccinated nearly 3 billion children in 122 countries, reducing polio cases by over 99.9%.
- Rotary announced a US\$2 million Programs of Scale grant to support farmers in India.
- Rotary club in India organized a tree plantation drive, planting over 500 saplings to promote environmental sustainability and combat climate change.
- Rotary clubs in India focused on health and education.
- Rotary India initiated a water conservation project aimed at improving water resource management and farming practices.
- Rotary members participated in the construction of a dam in India, funded by the Rotary Foundation under Global Grant #2461343.
