

PROGRAMMES OF SCALE GRANTS OF THE ROTARY FOUNDATION:

Programmes of scale grants are competitive grants that will benefit a large number of people in a significant geographic area using a sustainable, evidence-based intervention. They're designed to respond to a need that the community has identified and will have measurable outcomes and impact. Each grant will support, for three to five years, activities that align with one or more of Rotary's areas of focus. Cadre members will play an active role in this initiative and will help the Foundation evaluate the programmes.

The Rotary Foundation will award one grant each year in a process that requires a proposal and an application. Applicants will be asked to include a fully developed and highly sophisticated project design, as well as include baseline data and plans for monitoring and evaluation. The project should involve activities that have proved to be successful elsewhere. The clubs or districts with the strongest proposals will be invited to submit applications, which will include comprehensive details about the project.
