63. FLOWER FARMING PROJECT IN ASSOCIATION WITH SHANTHI NAGAR RESIDENCE ASSOCIATION

In collaboration with Rotary Club and Santhi Nagar Residents Association, the "Flower Farming" project successfully implemented by planting around 600 saplings of yellow and orange Bendi (Chendumally) in early July 2024. Within two months, the plants began flowering in September, yielding an impressive harvest. Till onam, approximately 150 kg of flowers have been sold at an average rate of ₹70 per kg, generating some revenue. In line with our project's social objective, the sale proceeds have been donated to support a marginalized final-year nursing student, covering his final-year exam fees. With the flowering season expected to continue for at least another month, we anticipate further sales and increased impact. Rtn. Ramakrishnan, chairman service project is instrumental for the successful completion of the project and show-casing public image of the Rotary.
