Sangamam 2024, the District Conference of RID 3232



District Conference Sangamam 2024 was conducted at IIT Research Park between 9th and 11 Feb. Desilting Rajakulam Pond



The Rajakulam Pond in Thiruvallur District was adopted by Rotary Club of Madras Temple City for desilting in partnership with Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research and HID India Pvt Ltd. The desilting resulted in an increase in the holding capacity of the pond from 40 Lakh Litres to 80 Lakh Litres of water as well as raise the ground water table of the area, benefitting about 5000 people. The Total cost of Rs.12 Lakhs came as a CSR contribution from HID India. A play area was also added to benefit the children of the village.

Free Cardiac Treatment for Children from Uganda



A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Dr.Kamakshi Memorial Hospital, RC Thiruvannamiyur and RC Madras to facilitate free cardiac treatment for 30 children identified with congenital heart disease in Uganda. The children will be evaluated at Dr.Kamakshi Memorial Hospital on arrival and treated by Dr. Prem Sekar, Interventional Paediatric Cardiologist (President of Rotary Club of Madras Temple City) and Dr.Prashant Shah, Paediatric Cardiothoracic Surgeon.

Rtn. Dr.Prem Sekar, President of Rotary Club of Madras Temple City and an Interventional Paediatric Cardiologist conducted a joint screening camp for children with congenital heart disease on 19th Feb 2024 at Senthil Nursing Home in Kumbakonam along with Rotary Club of Kumbakonam Central RID 2981. About 25 children were screened with Echocardiography for cardiac disease during the camp and were advised appropriate management. Rtn. Balaaji, the District Governor of RID 2981 was the Chief Guest.

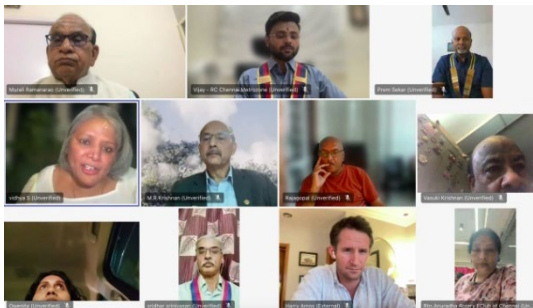
