

Celebrating Tradition and Innovation: My Golu Journey

Navarathri, celebrated in South India, is a vibrant tradition where dolls are beautifully arranged and stories of culture and mythology are shared, passing knowledge to the next generation. Since 2003, I have been actively participating in this tradition by creating my own Golu.

In 2018, I crafted a miniature of Mount Kailash and placed it on a round table for visitors to do Parikrama, a practice of circling sacred places. To my astonishment, my Golu caught the attention of Kanchi Periyava, one of the most revered spiritual leaders. He expressed a desire to see it, and I had the incredible opportunity to present my Golu at the Kancheepuram Mutt. After explaining my creation, Periyava was impressed and asked if I would gift it to the Mutt for display at the Maha Periyava Museum. Overjoyed, I gladly accepted and set it up in the museum myself.

Last year, I chose the theme of "Saranagathi" for my Golu, which received much appreciation from friends and family. It even won the "Best Golu" title from Adyar Times and a contest hosted by The Hindu newspaper.

For 2024, my theme is "Kurai Ondrum Illadha Govinda," inspired by Andal's 28th Thiruppavai, emphasizing that Lord Krishna is devoid of shortcomings. This theme, as heard in a discourse by Shri Dushyant Sridar explored the imagined shortcomings of Lord Rama and how Lord Krishna resolved them.















The stories I depicted included:

- 1. Lullabies: Rama felt deprived of lullabies from his mother, while Krishna chose two mothers, fulfilling Rama's wish.
- 2. **Fatherhood:** Rama was sent to the forest by his father. In contrast, Krishna had two protective fathers.
- 3. **Guru Repayment:** Rama couldn't repay his guru, while Krishna revived his guru's deceased children.
- 4. **Sisterly Love:** Rama lacked his sister's affection, but Krishna ensured the love of his sister, Yoga Maya.
- 5. Music Interest: Rama didn't pursue music due to shyness, whereas Krishna played the flute.
- 6. **Dancing Skills:** Rama didn't dance; Krishna showcased his talent on Kalinga, earning Lord Shiva's praise.
- 7. **Marriage Circumstances:** Rama felt unprepared for marriage as his marriage was due to circumstances, while Krishna loved multiple companions.
- 8. Divine Recognition: During Rama's coronation, Indra was absent, so Krishna made him perform a lesson in humility.
- 9. Charioteering Dreams: Rama's wish to be a charioteer was fulfilled when Krishna drove Arjuna's chariot.
- 10. Messenger Role: Krishna played the messenger for the Pandavas, fulfilling Rama's desire.
- 11. **Teachings:** Rama's limited verses in Ramacharana sloka contrasted with Krishna's expansive Gitopadesh, representing knowledge.
- 12. Curing Illness: Rama failed to cure Manthara; Krishna successfully healed Trivakra, addressing another of Rama's challenges.
- 13. **Offering Moksha:** Rama granted moksha for all in Ayodhya; Krishna performed extraordinary acts to do the impossible and fulfill Rama's desires.

While creating the 78 dolls needed to depict these scenarios would have been costly and impractical, I opted for a contemporary approach by generating Al drawings. My friend Selvakumar assisted me in obtaining these images, which captured the essence of my theme. The 2024 Golu received overwhelming praise, with numerous media outlets visiting to cover this unique blend of tradition and modern technology. It has been a joy to honor our cultural roots while embracing innovation. Through my Golu, I hope to inspire others and keep the spirit of storytelling alive for future generations.
