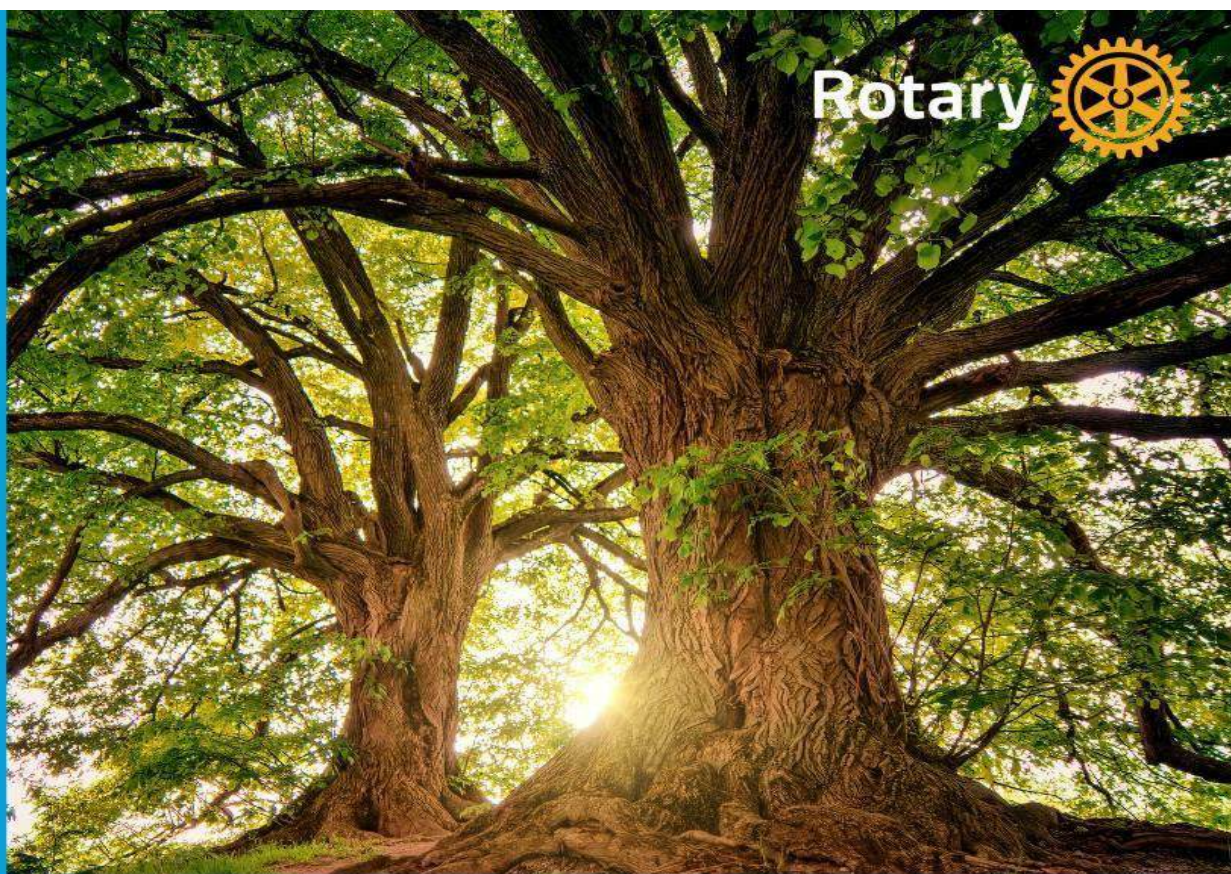

We all have a role to play in protecting our planet. Here are a few simple actions you can take:

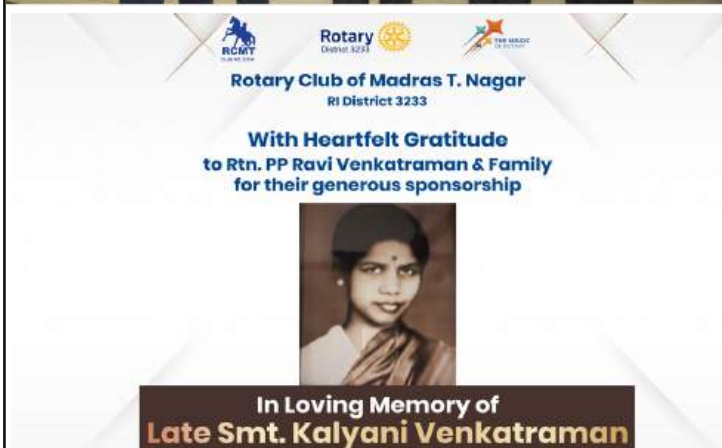

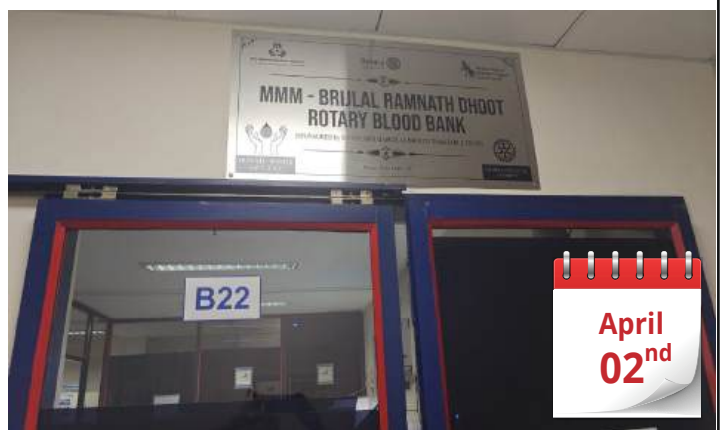

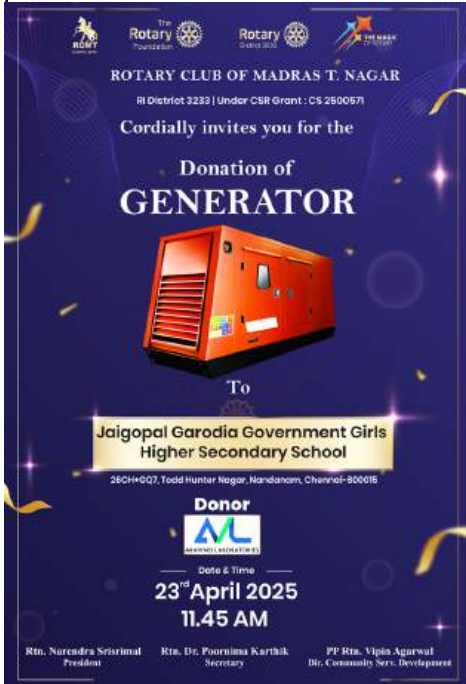
Generator Donation to Vivekananda Education Trust-Run School

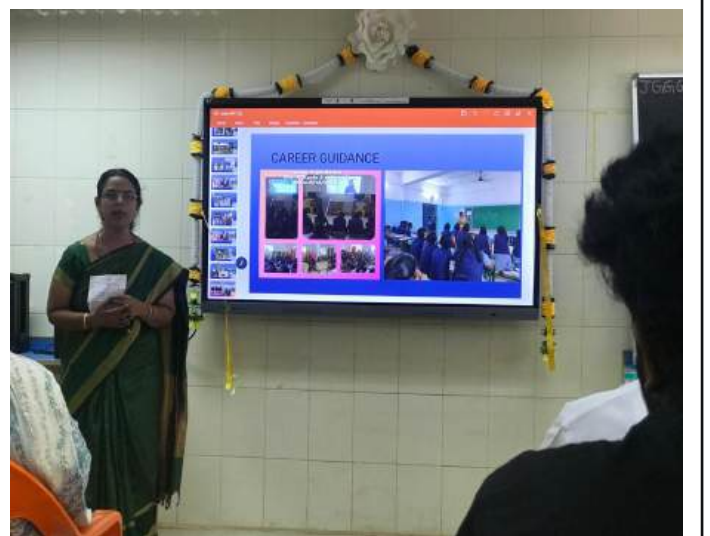
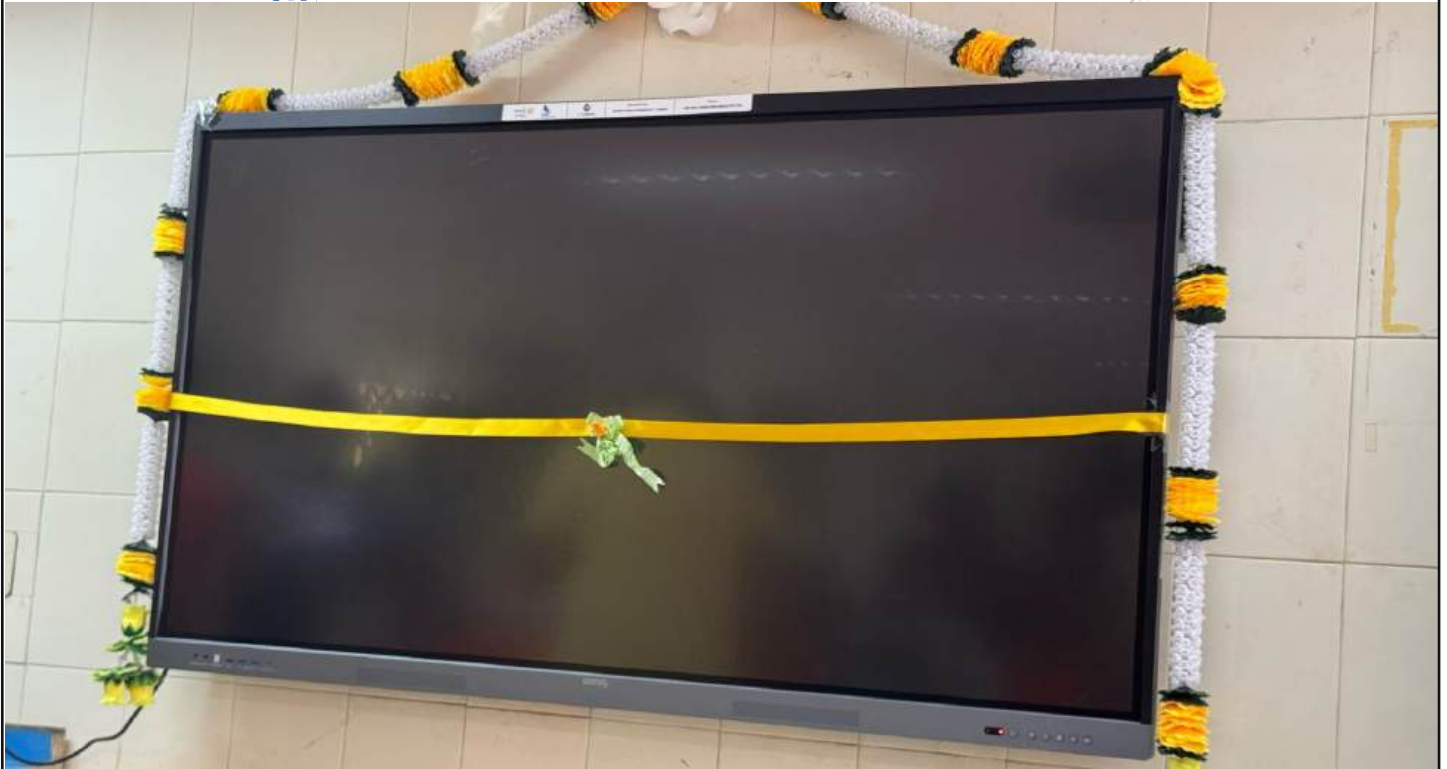

Donation of Medical Equipment to Voluntary Health Services (VHS), Chennai.

VHS is a non- profit healthcare organization that offers affordable and quality medical care services to the underprivileged.

To help VHS's commitment to providing superior healthcare, RCMT lent a helping hand by donating state of the art medical equipment. The equipment will be used in various departments in improving patient outcomes and helping medical staff provide timely interventions.

Donations worth Rs. 1.27 Crores with support from MCKS Trust*, RCMT was able to provide the following medical equipment and Support to VHS:

- 1) Ge Aisys Anaesthesia Workstation and Patient monitor for the department of Neurosurgery
- 2) Cell counter & Free Blood Transfusion support for children with Thalassemia to VHS Thalassemia Transfusion Centre
- 3) Takagi operating microscope with Binocular Optics & Digital Imaging System to the Ophthalmology Department

The new equipment was handed over to the hospital at a formal inaugural event held on 15th April 2025. 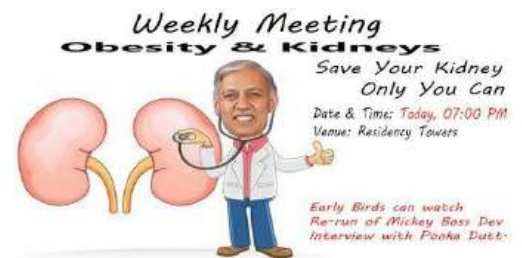

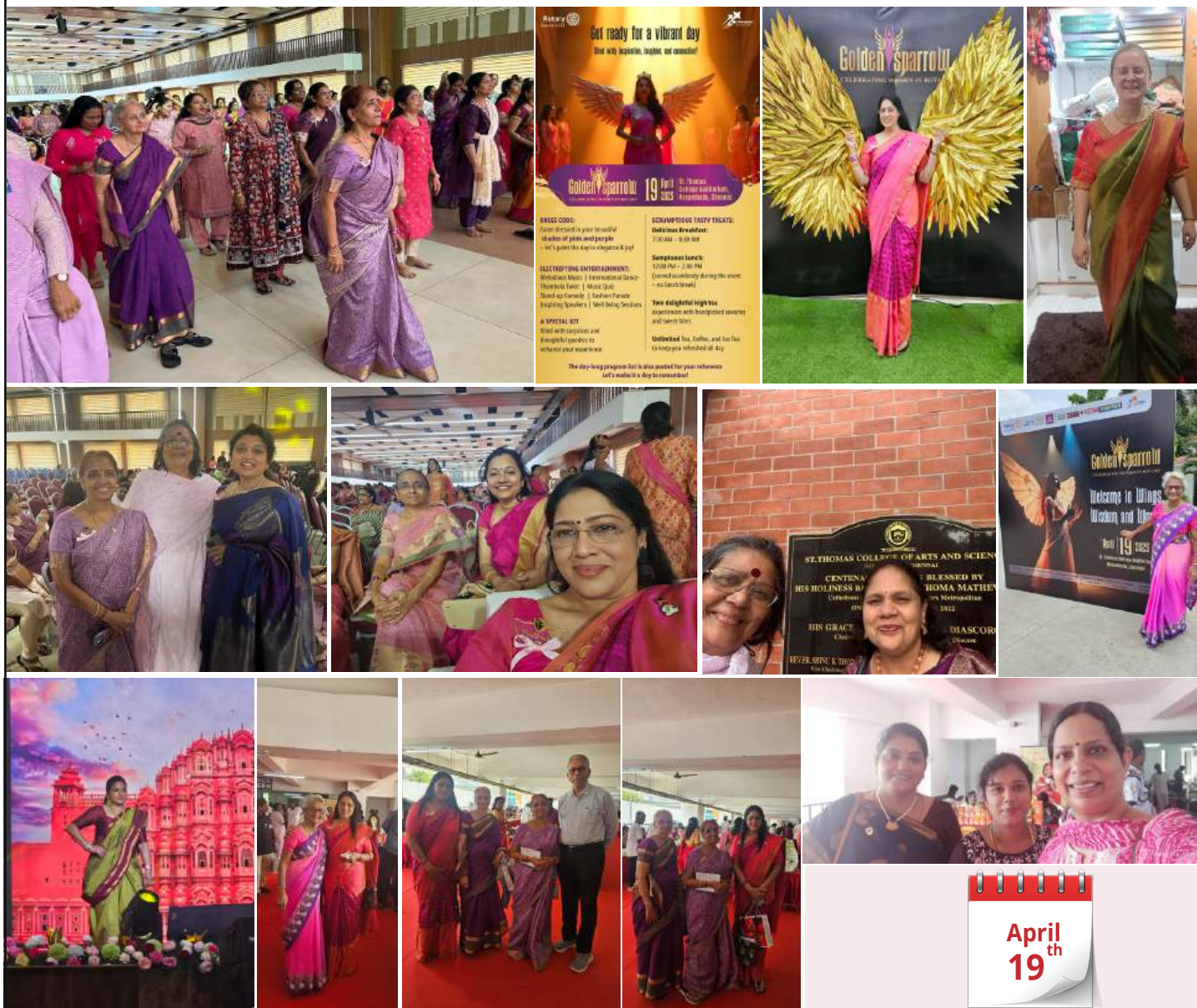
