I take this opportunity once again to thank all of you for vesting your confidence in me to keep up the legacy of this club .

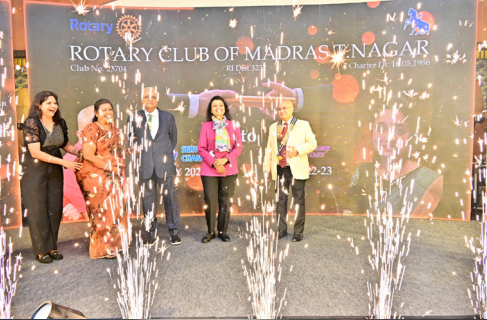
