The HeArt is where I belong!

As a young child of 5 growing up in a joint family I watched my uncle, a cartoonist and journalist do his cartoons for the week. A chalk thrown at me and the appetising red oxide flooring made me try and reproduce kamaraj, annadurai or rajaji on the floor. The result, a big spank from my mother for messing up the floor.

At school with no formal art training, and a natural disinterest in studies I would be doodling and scribbling the faced of my teachers on my note book at class. Finally, she caught me red handed. One look at my face and another look at her own face in my book, she dragged me to Mrs YGP's room.

Expecting a suspension and summoning of my parents, to my surprise she gave me art assignments for the school project, cutting class, to my absolute delight . First time I got recognition.

This technique I used in college with sketching and intercollegiate competitions, winning best student journalist in 1980 and haplily officially allowed to bunk classes.

I was drunk with a little fame and adulation especially from the opposite sex. My family and uncle got scared about my future .I had sketched Kanchi Periyava coming down the steps. Under the pretext of showing it, my uncle took me to the saint. He looked at my picture, smiled and said 'Padi' which meant both 'steps' and 'study' in Tamil. Promptly my art was packed up,only studies and profession and work for a full three decades.

Fate decided differently however, in 2016, an ipad gift from my daughter saw me renew my art, sketching and cartooning also conducting an exhibition and even releasing a book on Periyava sketches.

Social media and facebook changed my portfolio from a marketing & finance professional to a carefree caricaturist.

Then this year out of the blue, two of my sketches took me to meet the PM of the country, Narendra Modi and a casual 10 minute chit chat with him while presenting his portraits would always remain in my memory.

So, here I am, a chance artist, driven by destiny and pure passion, eventually succumbing to my inner love of reproducing a portrait or a profile picture or ridiculing an otherwise good looking face or painting a spiritual leader. I guess you can never take the art out of the heart after all, fate would ultimately take you to a place where you truly belong!




