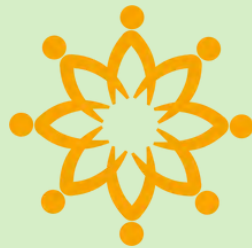
Weekly distribution of food packets

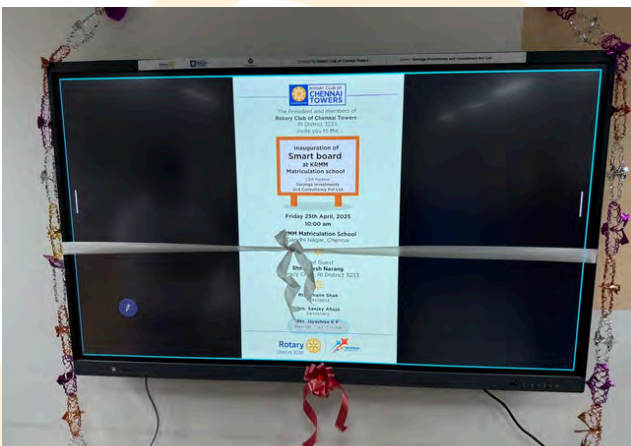
