



The "Say No to Plastics" initiative is part of Rotary District 3234's efforts to promote environmental sustainability and reduce plastic waste.








JOINT CLUB SPEAKER MEET - UNITE FOR GOOD








Interact Club Installation @Kesari Higher Secondary School
