

HPV Vaccination Project Update

This year, the aim to is to reach a target of 10,000 and eventually reach the target of one million by the centenary year. Rtn.Dr.Anuradha Ganesan, Rtn.A.M.Visvanathan and Rtn.Dr.Sangeetha Viswanathan had a

meeting with the Association President of Association of Inner Wheel Clubs in India Jyoti Mahipal, and a Letter of Intent was signed for a collaboration with Inner Wheel Club. Inner Wheel Club will promote awareness while RCM will handle the vaccination. The vaccination cost per child is Rs.2,500 which will be be shared by Inner Wheel (Rs.1,000) and RCM(Rs.1,500).
