Brief History Of the Club

The Rotary Club of Madras Ashok Nagar, chartered in November 1985, has been dedicated to community service from the start.

Initially raising funds internally for small projects, the club soon recognized the importance of collaborating with community members for long-term benefits.

Rotary Club activities, including social events and volunteer projects, foster networking and build personal and professional connections.

Over the years, the club has undertaken numerous initiatives across Rotary's service avenues: community, vocational, youth, and international service.

Regular projects include medical camps, vocational training for women, feeding orphans and the needy, blood donation camps, and road safety awareness programs.

The club has also provided infrastructure like toilets, kitchens, labs, and a water storage plant in a government-aided school.

The club's flagship project is providing hearing aids to children from lower socio-economic backgrounds.
