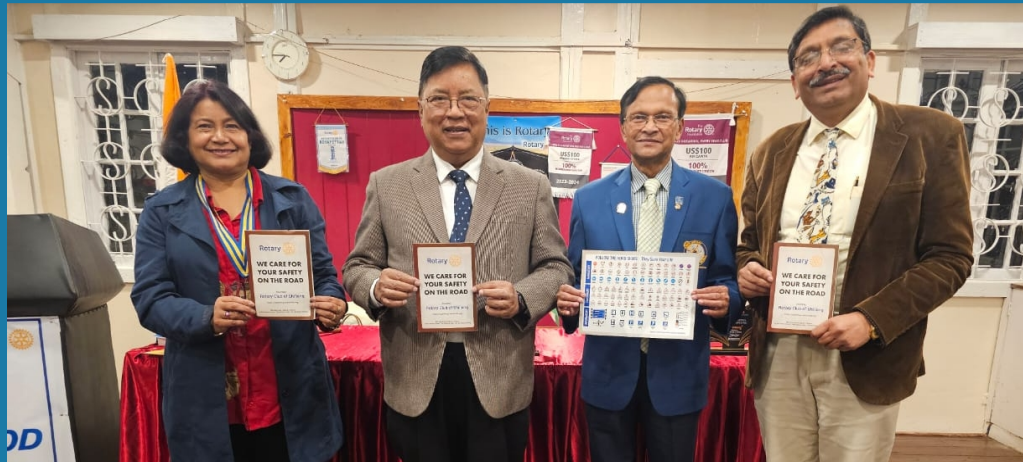

Egg Push Cards for beneficiaries in Sohra

Rotary Club of Shillong organised a programme of Handing Over of Egg Push Carts to the beneficiaries in Sohra , East Khasi Hills, Meghalaya.

The Egg Push Carts were sponsored by the National Egg Coordination Committee (NECC) , to support livelihood generation and self employment among the economically weaker sections of the society. The project aimed to promote nutrition, food security and sustainable income to beneficiaries while strengthening Rotary 's Community Service Outreach.

'Eggs are nutritious, affordable and in demand everyday'. Through this project, NECC has provided resources and Rotary is proud to be the bridge to deliver it to the community. Each Push Cart is provided with a Battery system with light, Cooking gas stove , Cooking utensils (including hot cases, pans) plates, spoons, stools etc . The beneficiaries have already received two days training by two Chefs from Polo Resort, Sohra, which included aspects on basic recipes, safe handling of eggs, hygiene etc.

The three Carts were handed over to the beneficiaries on the 9th May, Saturday, in Polo Resort, Sohra by Chandana Das, President, Rotary Club of Shillong in presence of the Club members, namely . Rtn. Sarad Bawri, Rtn. Sunial Arora, Rtn. Rohit Bajoria, Paiem M . System, Allan West and the other members of the community.

Rotary will conduct a review visit after three months to access income generation, Cart maintenance and challenges faced.

The Rotary Club of Bhavnagar, RID 3060, has planted 28,635 saplings over an area of 13,000 square metres using the Miyawaki method, known for creating dense, fast-growing native forests. This plantation will help enhance biodiversity, improve air quality, and develop a self-sustaining green ecosystem in the years to come. The Rotary Club of Seaface Surat built a toilet block for the students of the Saraswati Shishu Mandir, Bamroli. About 1,600 packs of reusable sanitary pads were distributed to 1,600 girl students of four local schools. The project was organised by the Rotary Club of Bhavnagar Royal, in collaboration with Rajkot Greater Unipads Foundation and State Bank of India's CSR grant, as part of District 3060's initiative.
