# Editorial .....!

February in Rotary calendar marks the anniversary of the first Rotary meeting which took place on February 23,1905 in Chicago. That is why this month is a special month for Rotary because it includes the anniversary of the first Rotary meeting. This month is also special because Rotary Theme for the month is PEACE AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION.

Everyone of us wish to live our lives in peace. Peace is a state of harmony in the absence of hostility and violence. In a societal sense, peace is commonly used to mean a lack of conflict such as war and freedom from fear of violence between individuals or groups. Promotion of peace is a core tenet many philosophies, religions and ideologies, many of which consider peace a core tenant of their philosophy. Psychological peace such as peaceful thinking and emotions is relatively less well defined, yet perhaps a necessary precursor to establishing Behavioural Peace. Peaceful behaviour sometimes results from a peaceful inner disposition.

A conflict is a situation in which unacceptable differences in interests, expectations, values, and opinion occur in or between individuals or groups. Conflict may be defined in different ways by different sources. One of such definition is " Disagreement, discrepancies, frictions and contradictions that occur when the actions or beliefs of a group are unacceptable to another group. Conflicts can trigger negative emotions like anxiety, fear, anger, and resentment, which can affect our physical and mental health. Unresolved conflict can damage relationships and make people feel sick. Conflict can also cause massive displacement of people, human rights violation, damage of work environment, inhibition of group cohesiveness, and disruption of peaceful social climate leading to huge economic loss.

Conflict may be resolved when inconsistency between wishes and actions of groups is resolved. Negotiation is an important part of conflict resolution. The goal of conflict resolution is an effective and lasting solution to the conflict.

We the Rotarians sincerely wish that at the end of the day PEACE SHALL PREVAIL and conflict is resolved constructively and satisfactorily. May a new dawn of PEACE AND PROSPERITY usher in like a miracle to my beloved Manipur sooner than later.




