Rotary Club of Imphal handed over eggs under Rotary Egg Bank Project at three children homes at Imphal on 8th May'2026 for the month of May'2026, benefiting 104 children of the three homes namely Yaibilen Children's Home, Keibi Sanapat, Imphal East, Poirei Nawakon Children's Home for girls, Leimakon Women's Abode Complex, Achanbigai, Imphal East and Punya Home, Thangmeiband Yumnam Leikai, Imphal West. This is a continuing community service project of Rotary Club of Imphal since 2021 benefitting these children of the homes in which 1680 eggs are to the three children homes every month so that a child at the home will get four eggs per week free of cost to provide nutritious food to children.

Chicken & egg push carts distributed

IMPHAL, May 17 : Rotary Club of Imphal and Rotary Club of Polo City Imphal, under Rotary International District 3240, on Sunday distributed 10 chicken and egg push carts to selected beneficiaries at a function held at Rotary Bhavan, Mantripukhri.

The carts were provided under the National Egg Coordination Committee (NECC) project worth Rs 1 crore.

In the first phase, 50 carts are being distributed across the Northeast, of which Manipur received 10. Each cart costs Rs 50,000.

Project coordinator Devkumar Thoudam said the carts will remain NECC

property for five years, with beneficiaries handling maintenance.

Each cart includes a battery, two LED lamps, a gas stove and utensils. Beneficiaries must obtain FSSAI license and municipal permits, and will receive Rs 2,000 as working capital.

Wangkhei AC MLA Thangjam Arunkumar, who attended as chief guest, urged beneficiaries to treat the carts as valuable opportunities and maintain hygiene.

He also handed over Rs 2,000 each to the beneficiaries.

The initiative follows Rotary Imphal's 2021 egg bank for children's and old-age homes, which prompted NECC's support.
