# Presidents' Speak ....!



# Editorial !

Today I will dwell on some random thoughts on ethics and integrity, a rare but essential traits of every human being in every society. We often dream of a Ramrajya, where Dharma (individual's moral responsibilities) is the cornerstone of impeccable perfectness. We Rotarians have our own edict of the "Four Way Test" to bind us to our professional and service excellence.

Ethics, in simple words, means moral philosophy. It is the study of moral phenomena. It investigates the nature of morality and principles that govern the moral evaluation of conduct, character, traits, and institutions. It examines what obligations people have, which behaviour is right or wrong and how to lead a morally responsible good life to bring about a harmonious, righteous, and progressive society. It deals with normative questions about what people ought to do or which act or behaviour is morally right. Consequentialism ethics will define whether an act is right if it leads to the best consequence. Deontology ethics, on the other hand, focuses on the acts themselves, saying that they must adhere to the morally responsible duties like telling the truth and keeping promises. Virtue ethics sees the manifestations of virtue like courage compassion, and righteousness as the fundamental principles of morality.

Integrity is the quality of being honest and having consistent and uncompromising adherence to strong moral and ethical principles and values. Integrity is regarded as the honesty, truthfulness and earnestness of one's actions and it can stand in opposition to hypocrisy. A person is said to possess the virtue of integrity if the person's actions are based upon an internally consistent framework of principles. These principles should uniformly adhere to sound logical axioms, postulates, or conscience. A person should have ethical integrity to the extent that their personal actions, beliefs, methods, measures, and principles align with a well-integrated core group values such as societal norms, societal values, religious values, and moral values so that his moral responsibilities get upheld for a better, productive, progressive, and virtuous outcome to the society.

Nowadays, in this contemporary world, ethics and integrity have become an ambiguous and vague concept. Moral responsibilities has become a conflicting, dilemma. The pressure of success, popularity, individual fame and gain, and fear of judgment often lead people astray from what is right. Nowadays ethics and integrity have apparently become a matter of choice between what is right and what is easy and profitable. Everyone expects others to adhere to ethics and integrity and criticise every other person, profession, and institution, but we must always remember that when we ourselves are tightly and sincerely bound to these moral responsibilities only then we can dream to achieve THE UTOPIA.


