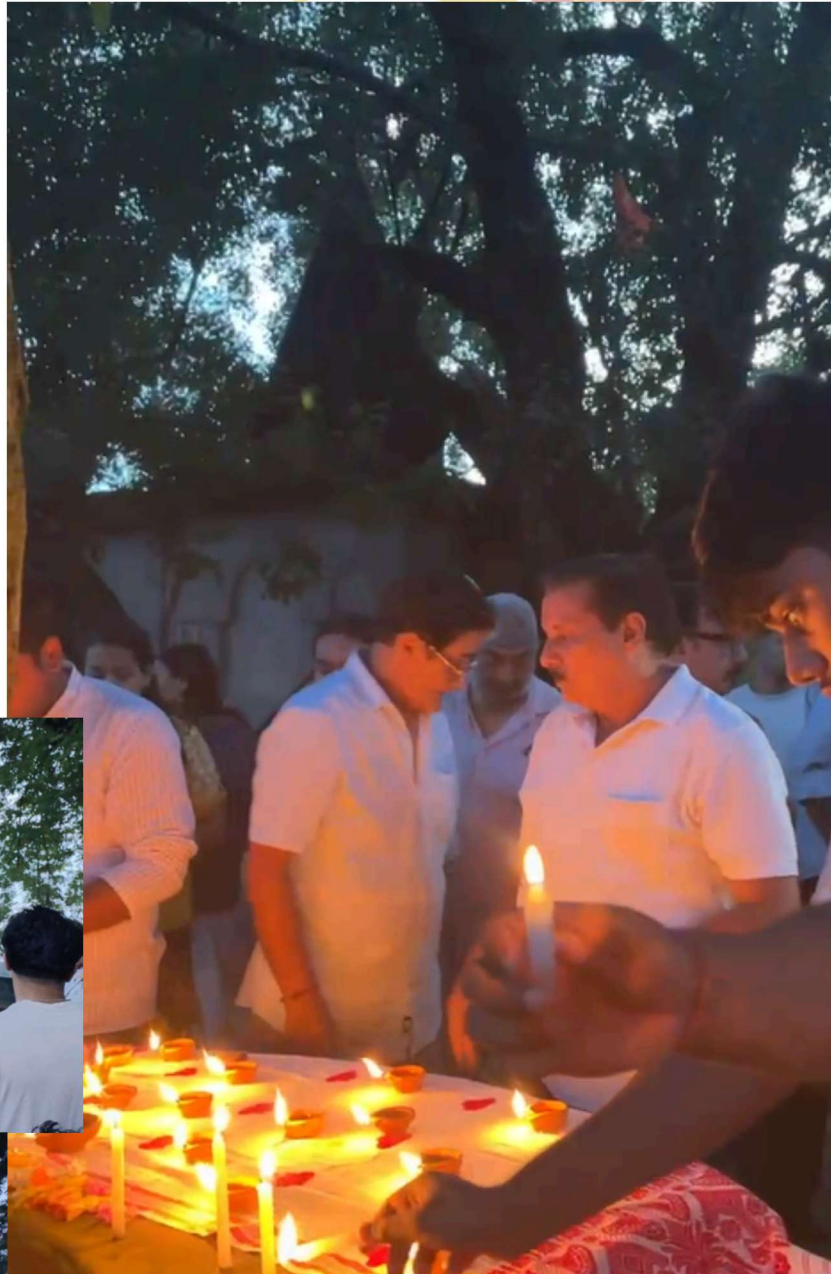




20TH SEPTEMBER

In a world often clouded by despair and uncertainty, the story of little Jiya and her family shines like a beacon of faith & resilience. Her story tells us that how as human we connect with other people without any bonds and links. This is story of a beautiful girl Jiya and a beautiful soul PDG Nilesh.

Just 20 days ago, Jiya's parents were navigating a maze of medical appointments, travel arrangements, financial uncertainty and emotional upheaval. Their daughter needed gamma surgery—a complicated & expensive surgical procedure requiring precision, patience, and courage. What followed was nothing short of serendipity and destiny being fulfilled.

During one of his visit to Rotary Palliative Care unit AT BCH hospital. Dr Jerine told PDG Nilesh about Jiya's case. He is father to 2 beautiful daughters and his meeting with Jiya moved him so much that he decided that he needs to help her to the maximum of his capacity.

PDG Nilesh helped by Dr Jerine made arrangements at AIIMS Delhi for the procedure. Without discussing or even asking for contribution from the club he remitted a substantial amount from his own finances towards surgery and logistics.

From the moment they arrived at the hospital, the family was met with warmth and efficiency. Every detail—from accommodation to doctor consultations—fell into place with astonishing ease. ***"It felt like someone had gone ahead of us and prepared the way,"*** her mother shared, eyes brimming with gratitude.

But the most extraordinary moment came during the surgery itself. Jiya, just a child, was required to remain completely still for over an hour. To everyone's amazement, she did. No fidgeting, no tears—just calm, quiet strength. Her parents watched in awe, convinced that this was more than medical success. It was divine intervention.

After the procedure, the family returned to The Baptist Christian Hospital to say thank you. They met with the medical team, shared their testimony, and praised God for His mercy and grace. Our members met the entire family along with now beaming Jiya. She is thriving. Her smile is brighter, her parents' hearts are lighter, and their faith is stronger than ever.

This story isn't just about recovery—it's about the power of community. A perfect example of how Rotarians are always in Action.

"We saw His hand in every step," her father said about PDG Nilesh, this testimony alone makes all of our hearts swell. He is a model Rotarian and inspires all of us to do ***"a little bit more and then some more"***.

- 20 PATIENTS WERE CONFIRMED FOR SUREGERY POST TESTS AND OTHER DIAGNOSIS.
- 7 PATIENTS UNDERWENT SURGERY ON 18TH SEPTEMBER. 2 WERE GIVEN CORRECTIVE GLASSES
- 8 SURGERIED SUCCESFULLY COMPLETED ON 25TH SEPTEMBER.
- “THE PEOPLE WHO UNDERWENT THE SURGERY WERE VERY POOR AND HAD NEVER IMAGINED THAT SUCH A PROCEDURE COULD RESTORE THEIR SIGHT. YET, IT DID — AND THEIR LIVES WERE CHANGED. EACH OF US CAN BRING SMALL MIRACLES INTO THE LIVES OF OTHERS, IF ONLY WE KEEP OUR HEARTS OPEN.” MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT HEMANAND.
