Eye & Dental health check up camp

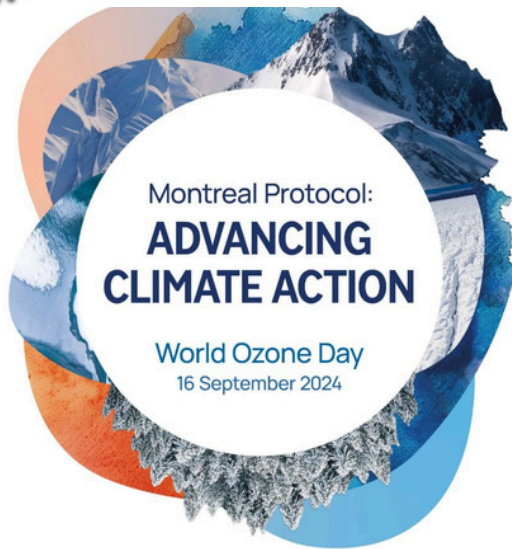
