Dr. Kameswar Singh Elangbam, a distinguished Orthopaedic Surgeon, hails from Imphal and is now settled in Shillong, Meghalaya. He completed his MBBS from Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh; D.Ortho from Aligarh Muslim University; and MS Orthopaedics from AIIMS, New Delhi, where he also served as Registrar. He is an AO Fellow in Trauma Surgery (Germany) and received advanced training in complex trauma management at Davos, Switzerland.

He has held various clinical and administrative roles, retiring as Additional Mission Director (NRHM), Government of Meghalaya. Currently, he practices at Kamber Clinics & Kamber Polyclinics, Shillong. Dr. Elangbam is a life member of the Indian Orthopaedic Association, Bombay Orthopaedic Society, NEROSA (President), and East Zone Orthopaedic Forum (President). He has spoken at and organized several national and international conferences and symposia.

A committed Rotarian since 2007, Dr. Elangbam is a Major Donor Level III, PHS Member, End Polio Fellow, and Benefactor. As Diamond Jubilee President of Rotary Club of Shillong, he led impactful initiatives like the Rotary Dialysis Centre and rural empowerment programs in Mawphlang. Internationally, he's contributed to water and sanitation projects in Bhutan and Sri Lanka.

He's represented Rotary in global events including RI Conventions (Seoul, Atlanta, Hamburg), the World Water Summit, RI Peace Conference in Beirut, and Institutes in Malaysia and Indonesia. He is active in RAGAS (National Coordinator), WASRAG, ESRAG, and various Rotary fellowships, and coordinated the Rotary Sohra Marathon.
