Rotary International's End Polio Campaign, launched through it's Polio Plus Programme in 1985, has been a cornerstone of Global Health Efforts, aiming to eradicate polio wordwide.

Riding on supports of partners, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the World Health Organisation, UNICEF, and the US Centers for Desease Control and Prevention, Rotary has made significant strides in reducing polio cases by over 99.9% since 1988.

The partnership has resulted in active immunisation of over 2.5 billion children in 122 countries, bringing the world closure to achieving a polio free future. Despite challanges, including fund cuts and fragile health systems, Rotary remains committed to achieve goal of polio free world.

As the world observes World Polio Day on October 24, 2025, Rotarians and partners worldwide are urged to recommit to the promise of a polio free world, emphasizing the need for sustained efforts and funding to finally eradicate this debilitating desease.

Our club is actively participating in this campaiogn of eradication of polio by raising funds and contributing at the same time to support this programme. One of our esteened member Dr Pallvi Majhi has been a front runner in contributing fund to the Programme of 'End Polio'. A massive Rally, to create awareness in the community has been held at 06.30 hrs on 24 th October, 2025, from Baronilpur More to Aravind Stadium in the heart of Burdwan City.

A 500 ft long TIFO with End Polio Now 'printed on it, will be demonstrated by the rally walkers.

The President also called upon the members to attend and volunteer at RYLA, to be held at the Global Magnus School, Burdwan, on 21st to 23rd November.

Past President Rtn. Dr. Pallabi Majhi told the members about RLI at Guwahati held on 11th and 12th October.
