


#### **Know our Guest Speakers**



#### Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dr. S.N. Pathak

Hon'ble Dr. **Justice** Shiva Nand Pathak born 15.01.1963. After on graduating in History (Hons.) from Bihar National College, Patna University, His Lordship pursued Masters in History in the year 1985

and LL.B. in the year 1988 from Patna Law College. His Lordship was subsequently awarded Ph.D. from the same University. Enrolled as an Advocate on 26.08.1988 with Bihar State Bar Council and started practicing in the High Court of Patna. His Lordship practiced in Civil, Criminal, Revenue and Constitutional matters. It was only after bifurcation of the state his Lordship shifted his practice to Jharkhand High Court. His Lordship was designated as Senior Advocate in the year 2010 in Jharkhand High Court.

During his tenure as an advocate, His Lordship argued more than 2000 cases, showcasing his profound dedication and commitment to justice. His Lordship had expertise in the Police manual and appeared in numerous cases representing individuals from constables to the Director General of Police, showcasing the breadth of his legal knowledge and experience.

His elevation as a Judge of High Court on 19th September'2018 was looked into as the hallmark of Justice. His Lordship has been shinning and brimming since then.

His Lordship had occasion and privilege to attend International and National seminars including the seminar at Lucknow, Agartala, Guwahati, Bhopal, Banaras Hindu University and many other places found importance. Having roots in Buxar, His Lordship has the privilege and blessings of Lord Shiva to get the biggest temple of Lord Shiva at Bahrampur, Buxar (hometown) renovated under the guidance of His Lordship and thereafter the same was inaugurated by Hon'ble The Chief Minister of Bihar on 27.01.2024.

His Lordship in the High Court is heading several committees. He is the chairman of Family Courts Sensitization Matter Committee and has headed Juvenile Justice Committee for 4 long years. At Present, he is the active member of the New Building Committee of Jharkhand High Court which was inaugurated by the Her Excellency, President of India, Ms. Draupadi Murmu and Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India, Hon'ble Mr. Justice D.Y. Chandrachud on 12th May 2023. Apart from the above, his Lordship is the active member of the following committees:

Minutes of the 3517th meeting of Rotary Club of Ranchi held on 04.07.2024.
