President informed that the focus for the day shall be NID - 3rd phase for Pulse Polio Immunization on 25th August.

Dr. Kumar Sudhanand, WHO, distributed a ward-wise list of high-rise residential buildings across Ranchi. This list was shared with all Rotarians and Rotaractors present, who were tasked

with forming groups of 3-4 volunteers according to the ward convenient to them.

PDG Rtn. Jogesh Gambhir emphasized that while India is a polio-free country, the threat of polio returning remains, as it is still present in some neighbouring countries. The only way to keep India polio-free and victorious is by regularly immunizing children up to 5 years old.

Acting Secretary PP Rtn. Harminder Singh mentioned that Rotaractors need to visit the Secretaries of RWAs in high-rise apartments to create awareness through banners, posters, and social media. They should ensure that on 25th August, children up to 5 years old are taken to the nearest booth to receive the essential polio dose. Additionally, on 26th and 27th August, Rotaractors should support polio workers in their door-to-door activities to ensure no child is left without receiving the polio dose.

President Rtn. Gaurav Bagroy, PDG Rtn. Jogesh Gambhir, PP Rtn. Harminder Singh & Dr. Kumar Sudhanand released banners and posters for the Pulse Polio immunisation campaign. Later, PP Rtn. Pravin Rajgadia also issued a press release regarding the same.

The President announced that to raise awareness, on August 24th at 6:30 AM, all the Rotary and Rotaract clubs of Ranchi will gather near Bapu Vatika, Morabadi Ground, for an awareness rally on Pulse Polio immunization.

The President expressed gratitude to the Fellowship Committee for arranging the fantastic fellowship event.

The collection in the Sunshine Box was 530 degrees.
