
MARCH IS WATER, SANITATION, AND HYGIENE MONTH

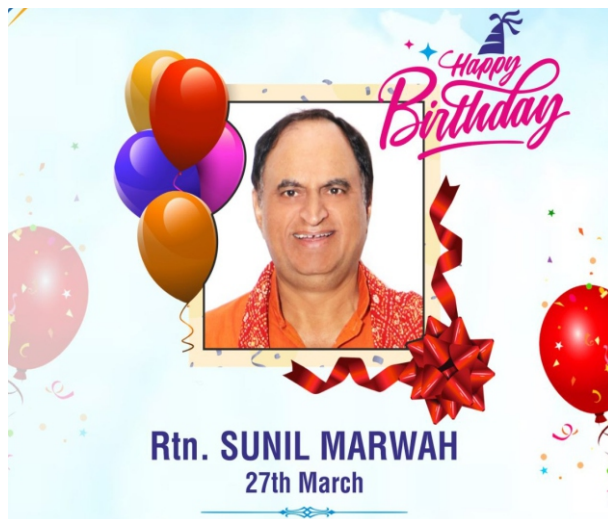
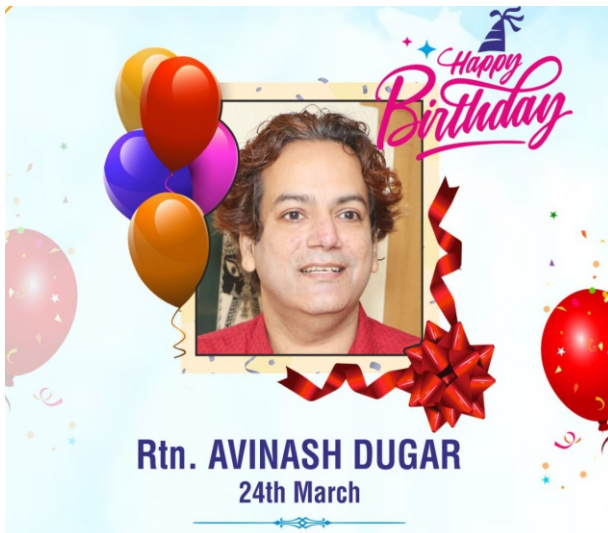
RCJ EYE-DIAGNOSTIC VAN
