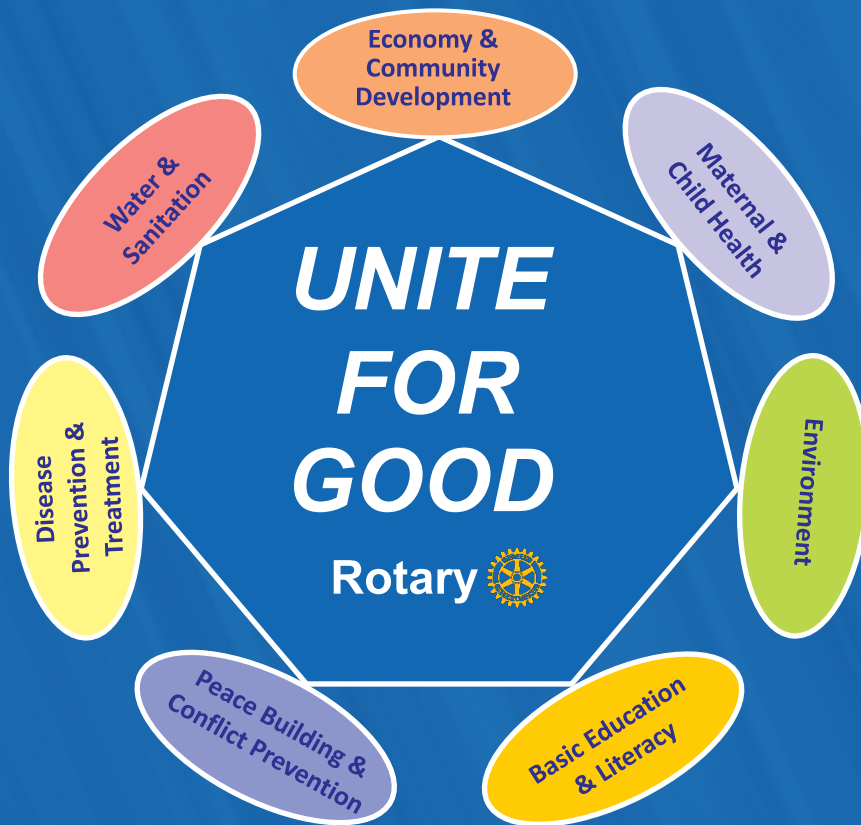

17. Rtn. Dr. Manju Singh, presented the Sergeant-at-arms report as under:

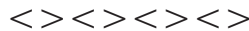
