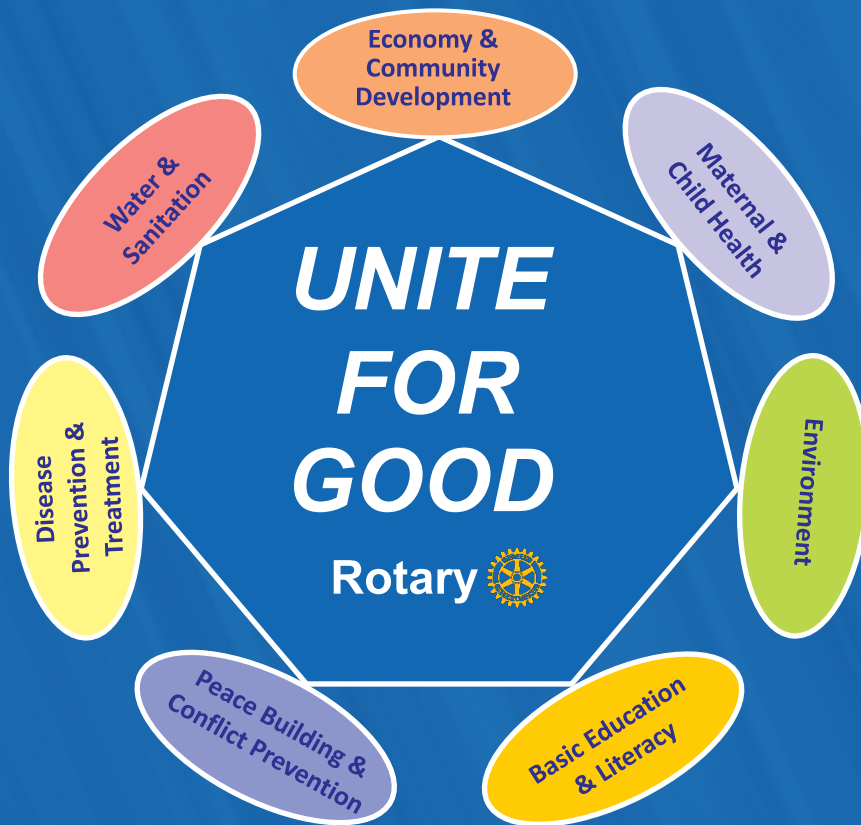

ROTARY CLUB OF JAMSHEDPUR - PACEMAKER PROJECT

Mr. Arun Gorai from Birsanagar (Jamshedpur) began losing consciousness on the night of 27th April. At TMH, his heart rate was found to be critically low (below 40 bpm), requiring urgent pacemaker implantation.

He belongs to a family of 8, with his son as the sole earning member working as a construction labourer, earning around ₹15,000 per month—making the procedure unaffordable.

With the support of Rotary, and the generous sponsorship by District Governor Rtn. Namrata, a pacemaker was successfully implanted on 2/5/26.

Due to the urgency, Dist. Governor Rtn. Namrata Mam transferred the money directly online to the Hospital, thus saving substantial time in the process.

Total Project Cost: ₹54,114.

This is the 13th pacemaker under the Pacemaker Project this year. Though funds usually allow only 10 cases annually, the continued generosity of kind-hearted Rotarians ensures the project serves without interruption.
