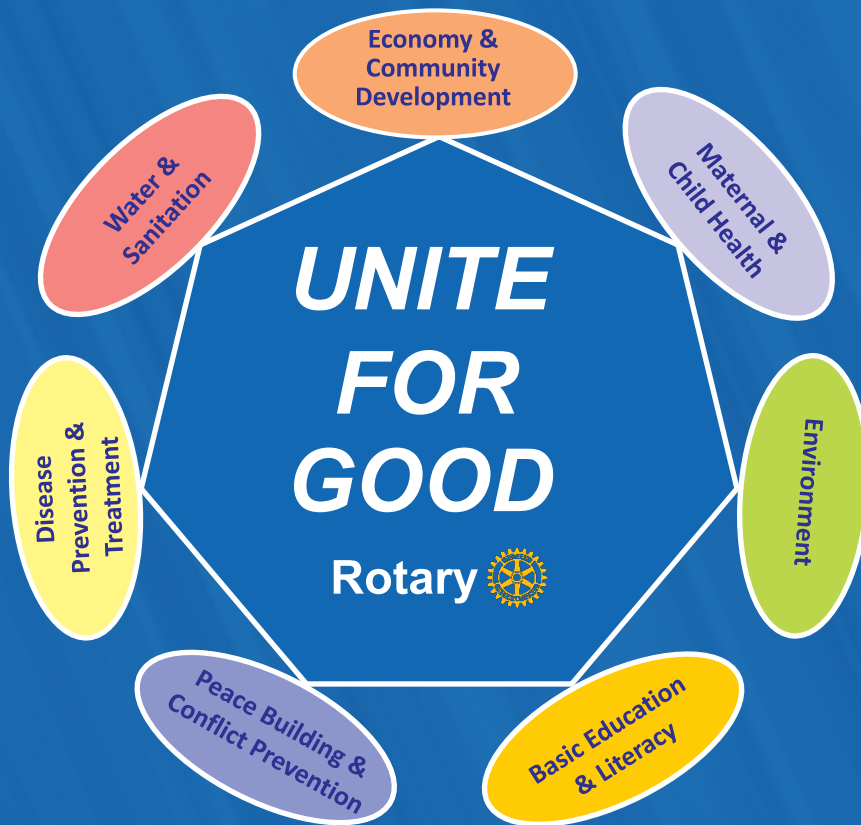

OUR BELOVED RTN. K.P.G. NAIR

Rtn. K.P.G. Nair (Kaitharathu Purushothaman Gopalakrishnan Nair), born on 19th June 1949, was a distinguished engineer, educator, and community leader whose life was defined by excellence, leadership, and service. With postgraduate qualifications in Mechanical Engineering (Production Management) from Regional Institute of Technology, Jamshedpur, and Business Management from XLRI, he built an illustrious career spanning over four and a half decades with Tata Steel. He played a pivotal role in design, engineering, equipment manufacturing, and major expansion and modernization projects, including those at Kalinga Nagar, Odisha. Even after his superannuation in 2009, he continued to contribute as a consultant and advisor in engineering and project management for over a decade.



Deeply committed to education and social upliftment, Mr. Nair was associated with Kerala Samajam Model School (KSMS), Jamshedpur, for more than 35 years, serving as its Chairman for the last 8–9 years. He also contributed as Chairperson of Vidya Jyoti School, Gamharia, and was actively involved in various school management committees and educational initiatives impacting thousands of students. In recognition of his outstanding contribution to education, he was honoured with the Educational Leadership Excellence Award at the Education Excellence Conclave held in Kolkata on 6th December 2025.

An active Rotarian, Rtn. KPG Nair made significant contributions to the Rotary Club of Jamshedpur, particularly through the Literacy Committee. He was instrumental in organizing English spoken classes for Hindi school students and their parents, along with vocational training programs that empowered students with practical skills and enhanced opportunities for their future.

A recipient of multiple accolades, including a gold medal in finance from XLRI and recognition for enabling ISO certification and educational excellence, he was also an active member of professional bodies such as the Institute of Engineers.

Remembered for his humility, vision, and unwavering commitment to society, Mr. Nair left this world on 17th March 2026, leaving behind a lasting legacy that continues to inspire generations.
