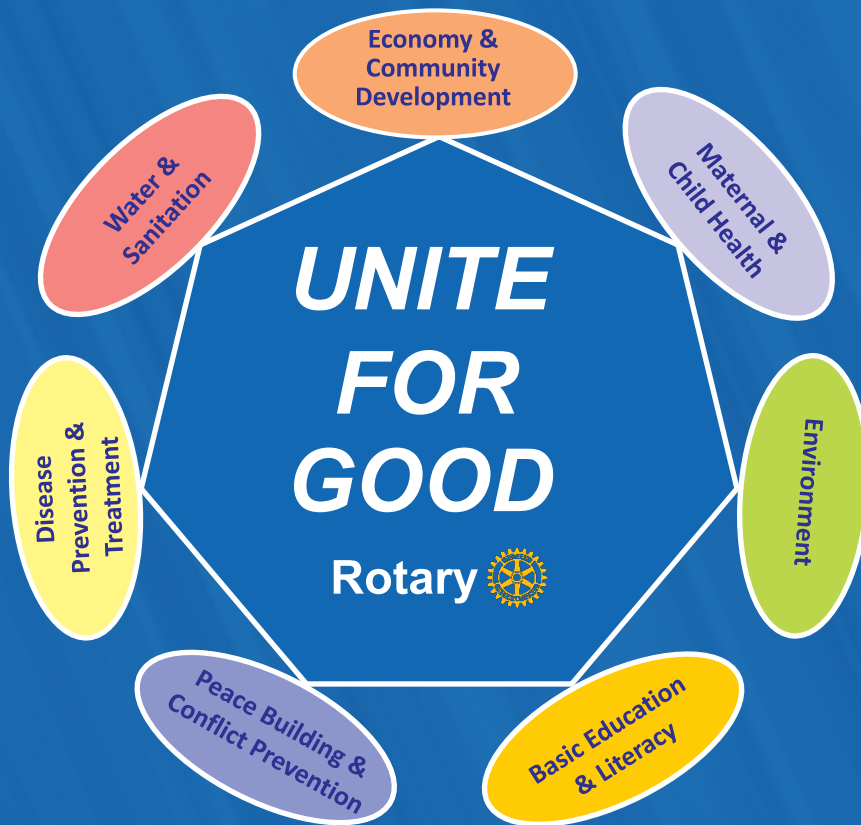

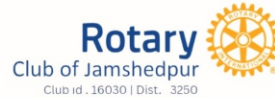

Organised at Jagannathpur & Dimkadih Villages on 02nd May 2026, this was the 1st event of May and 44th Event of RY 2025-26.

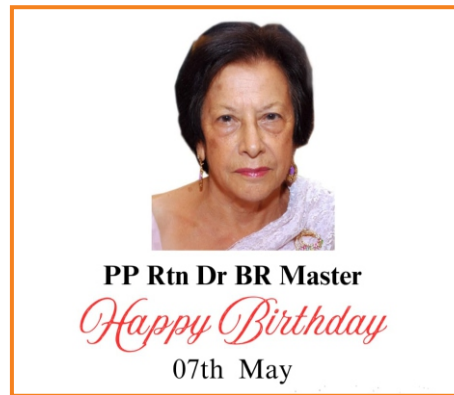
