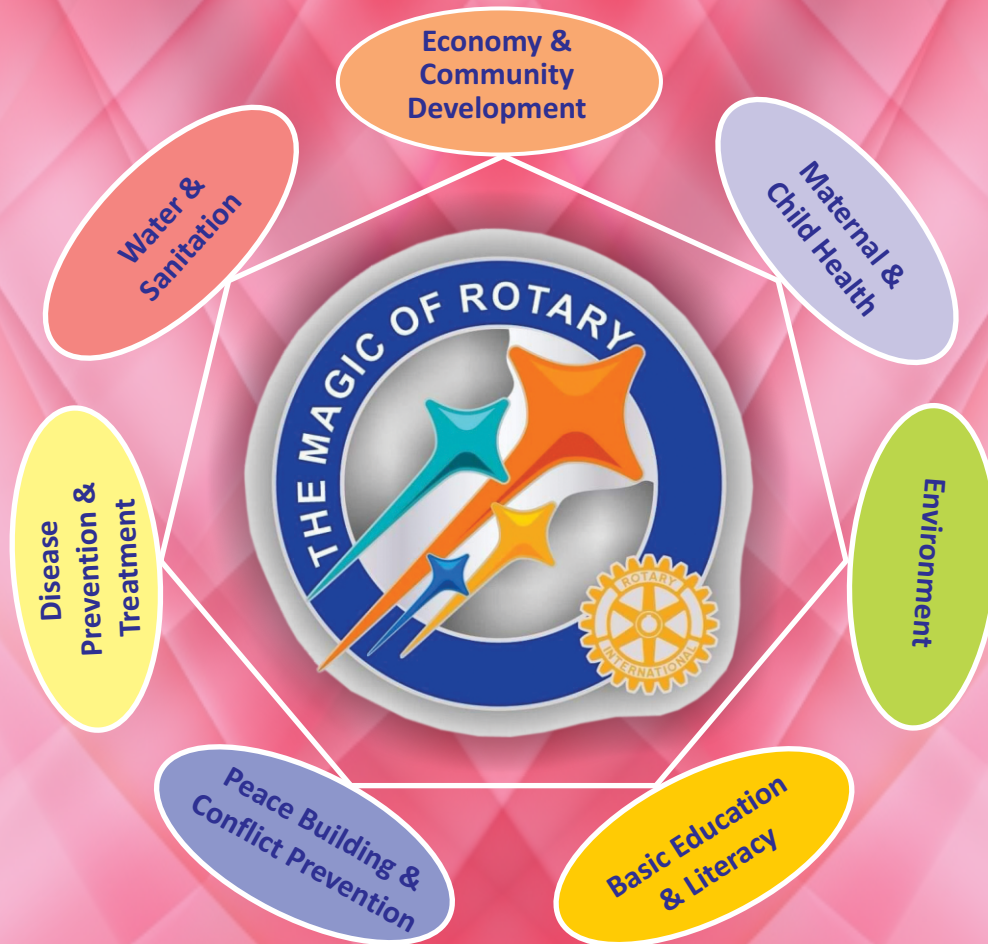

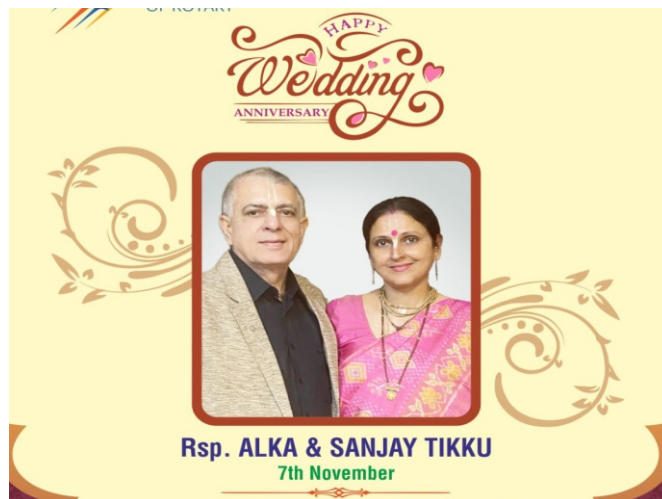
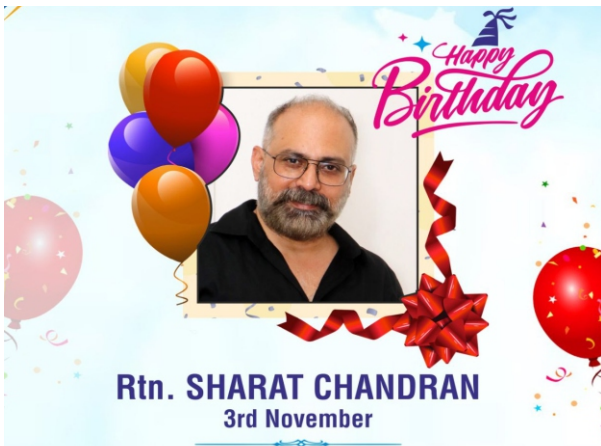
RCJ FOOD FOR ALL COMMITTEE
