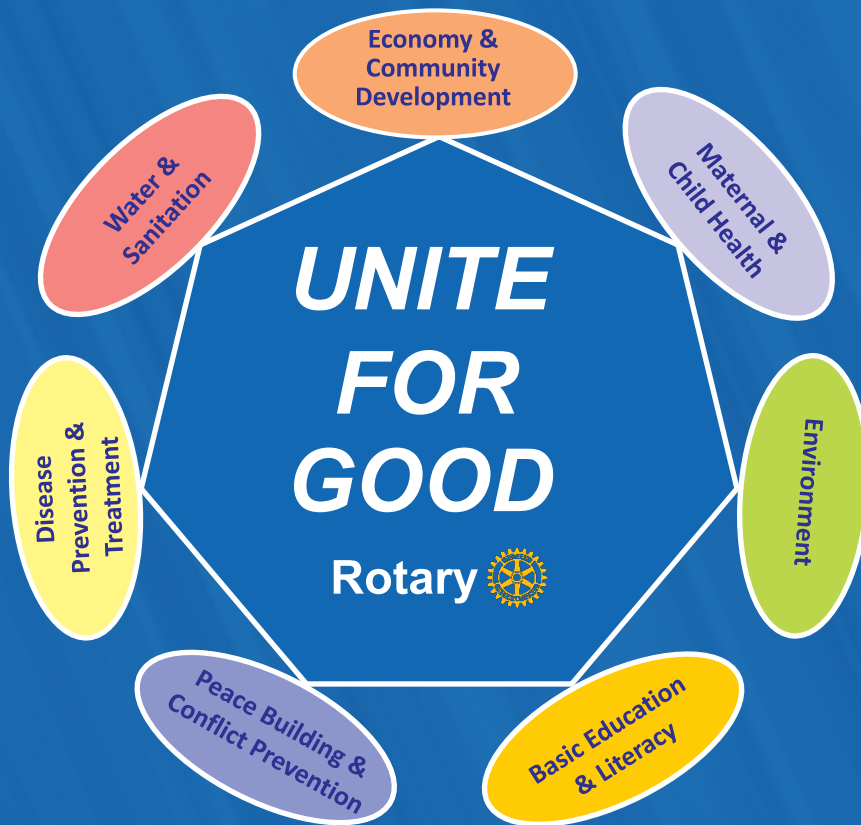

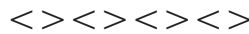
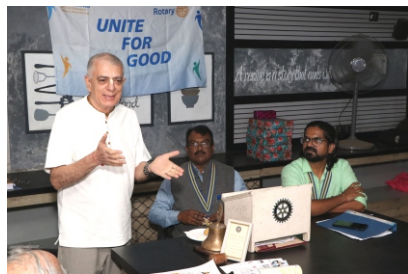
## GLIMPSES AT THE WEEK'S EVENTS & ACTIVITIES RCJ REGULAR MEETING

## UJJWAL DRISHTI ABHIYAN – VISION SCREENING INITIATIVE (TILL 31 MARCH 2026)

Under the Ujjwal Drishti Abhiyan, the Rotary Club of Jamshedpur has been actively conducting vision screening programs for school children (Class III and above), aimed at early detection of visual defects and providing spectacles to needy students.

This initiative is being implemented through the Satellite Eye Screening Van under the Global Grant Project (GG2234135, RY 2021–22) in collaboration with Jamshedpur Eye Hospital.

### School Screening Highlights (RY 25-26 Till 31.03.2026)

25 camps conducted. 1506 students screened.  
265 students identified with refractive errors.  
Corrective measures, including provision of spectacles, have been extended to students requiring vision support.

### Overall Impact of the Eye Screening Van (RY 25-26 Till 31.03.2026)

140 camps organized. 2678 beneficiaries screened. 1223 refractive errors detected. 409 spectacles distributed (at subsidized rates). 180 cataract surgeries successfully conducted.

The van has covered 10,792km in RY 25-26 till date.
