



पोलियो का तुरंत अंत करें अभियान को निरंतर सशक्त बना रहा हैं जमशेदपुर रोटरी क्लब

जमशेदपुर। पोलियो जैसी घातक बीमारी के खिलाफ वैश्विक जंग में

रोटरी इंटरनेशनल की भूमिका ऐतिहासिक रही है। 1985 से रोटरी ने विश्व स्वास्थ्य संगठन, यूनिसेफ और बिल एंड मेलिंडा गेट्स फाउंडेशन के साथ मिलकर ग्लोबल पोलियो उन्मूलन पहल (जीपीईआई) के माध्यम से इस बीमारी को समाप्त करने का



अभियान चलाया। परिणामस्वरूप, आज दुनिया में पोलियो के मामलों में 99.9 प्रतिशत से अधिक की कमी आई है। भारत में इस अभियान की सफलता का बड़ा श्रेय जमशेदपुर की रोटेरियन डॉ. बचू रोहिंटन मास्टर को जाता है, जिन्होंने पूर्वी भारत में पहली पल्स पोलियो ड्राइव की शुरुआत की। उन्होंने चिकित्सकों, प्रशासन और स्वयंसेवकों को जोड़कर झुग्गी-बस्तियों तक टीकाकरण पहुँचाया। पोलियोप्लस समिति की अध्यक्ष के रूप में उन्होंने जन-जागरूकता बढ़ाई और हजारों बच्चों को सुरक्षित बनाया। उनकी निष्ठा और सेवा को रोटरी के सर्वोच्च सम्मान सेवा सर्वोपिर से सम्मानित किया गया। जमशेदपुर के रोटरी क्लब आज भी उनकी दृष्टि को आगे बढ़ाते हुए पोलियों का तुरंत अंत करें अभियान को निरंतर सशक्त बना रहे हैं। रोटरी की यह प्रतिबद्धता इस विश्वास को जीवित रखती है कि कोई भी बच्चा ऐसी बीमारी से पीडित न हो जिसे रोका जा सकता है।


